



Block 14: Square in a Square - Betsy Chutchian

Use (1) light and (1) dark fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

- A (2) squares, 2 ½" x 2 ½" □ (LIGHT)
- B (1) square, 2" x 2" (DARK)
- C (2) squares, 2 ½" x 2 ½" □(DARK)
- E (2) squares, 4" x 4" □ (DARK)
 - \square = cut once diagonally from corner to corner

Assembly

- Lay (2) A triangles onto opposite sides of (1)
 B square; center and pin in place. Sew together and press toward B. Repeat using (2) A triangles on remaining two sides. Square-up
- pieced unit to a 2 %" square.








2. Repeat Step 1 by sewing (4) C triangles to the pieced unit, two at a time; press toward C's. Square-up unit to 3 ½" square.








3. Repeat process by sewing (4) D triangles to the pieced unit, two at a time; press toward pieced unit. Square-up unit to 4 ¾" square.








4. Lastly, sew (4) E triangles to the pieced unit, two at a time; press toward E's to create the Square in a Square block measuring 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
