




Block 20: Devil's Claws - Betsy Chutchian

Use (1) light and (1) dark fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

- A (2) squares, 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" ☒ (LIGHT)
- B (2) squares, 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" ☒ (DARK)
- C (2) squares, 2 ¾" x 2 ¾" \((LIGHT) \)
 - D (2) squares, 2 ¾" x 2 ¾" \(\square \) (DARK)
- \square = cut once diagonally from corner to corner
 - \boxtimes = cut twice diagonally from corner to corner

Assembly

1. Sew (1) A triangle to (1) B triangle; press toward B for a pieced triangle. Make (2). Sew pieced triangles together; press seam open to make Unit #1.








2. Sew (2) D triangles to (1) A triangle; press toward D's. Make (2) Flying Geese, Unit #2.






3. Sew together (1) A triangle (2) B triangles, and (2) C triangles, as shown; press toward B's. Make (2) Unit #3.



4. Lay out Unit #1, Unit #2's, and Unit #3's, as shown. Sew Unit #2's to Unit #1; press toward Unit #2's. Sew rows together (press toward Unit #3's) to create the Devil's Claws block measuring 6 ½" square.
