



Block 25: Twice the Friendship - Kansas Troubles Quilters, Lynne Hagmeier, Designer Use (1) light, (1) medium, and (1) dark fabrics. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

## **KT Layered Patchwork**

- A (9) squares, 2 ½" x 2 ½" (LIGHT)
- B (2) squares, 2 ½" x 2 ½" ☐ (MEDIUM)
- C (4) squares, 1 ½" x 1 ½" \( \square\) (DARK)
- $\square$  = cut once diagonally, corner to corner

- 1. Layer (1) A triangle on (1) B square, right sides up and aligning corners, as shown; glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edge of A triangle with
- coordinating cotton thread. Make (4) units.





2. Layer (1) C triangle on unit from Step 1 with right sides up and aligning corners; glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edge of C triangle with coordinating thread. Make (4) Unit #1.







3. Layer (4) C triangles on (1) B square, aligning corners, gluing in place, and top stitching 1/8" from bias edges, as shown. Make (1) Unit #2.





4. Lay out Unit #1's, Unit #2, and B squares. Sew into rows; press all rows toward Unit #1's. Sew rows together (press open) to create the Twice the Friendship block measuring  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
