

## Block 26: Cat's Cradle - Betsy Chutchian

Use (1) light and (1) dark fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

A - (3) squares, $17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (LIGHT)
B - (9) squares, $17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 17 / 8 "$ (DARK)

- cut (6) B squares $\triangle$

C - (3) squares, $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \boxtimes$ (LIGHT)

1. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of (1) A square and place on (1) B square, right sides together; pin in place. Stitch a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance on each side of drawn line. - Cut in half and press pieced squares toward B. Make (6).

2. Sew (2) B triangles to (1) pieced square from Step 1, as shown. Make (6) pieced triangles.

3. Sew (1) pieced triangle from Step 2 to (1) C triangle, as shown. Make 6 pieced units.

4. Lay out pieced units and $D$ squares, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press open) to create the Cat's Cradle block measuring $61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ square.
