



## Block 26: Cat's Cradle - Betsy Chutchian

Use (1) light and (1) dark fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

A - (3) squares, 1 %" x 1 %" (LIGHT)

B - (9) squares, 1%" x 1%" (DARK)

• cut (6) B squares 

□

C - (3) squares, 2 % x 2 % \( \sqrt{LIGHT} \)

D - (3) squares, 2 ½" x 2 ½" (LIGHT)


 $\square$  = cut once diagonally from corner to corner

## Assembly

1. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of (1) A square and place on (1) B

square, right sides together; pin in place. Stitch a 1/4" seam allowance on each side of drawn line.

Cut in half and press pieced squares toward B.
 Make (6).







2. Sew (2) B triangles to (1) pieced square from Step 1, as shown. Make (6) pieced triangles.






3. Sew (1) pieced triangle from Step 2 to (1) C triangle, as shown. Make 6 pieced units.


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4. Lay out pieced units and D squares, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press open) to create the Cat's Cradle block measuring  $6 \frac{1}{2}$  square.
