




Block 33: Starz - Jo Morton

Use (1) light and (1) dark fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

- A (4) squares, 1 %" x 1 %" (LIGHT)
- B (4) squares, 1 %" x 1 %" (DARK)
- C (8) squares, 1 ½" x 1 ½" (DARK)
 - D (8) squares, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " (LIGHT)
- E (4) rectangles, 1 ½" x 2 ½" (DARK)
 - F (4) rectangles, 1 ½" x 2 ½" (LIGHT)
 - G (1) square, 2 ½" x 2 ½" (LIGHT)


Assembly

1. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of (1) A square and place on (1) B square; pin in place. Stitch a ¼" seam allowance on each side of drawn line. Cut in half and press pieced squares toward B. Make (8).













Unit #1

3. Layer (1) D square on one end of (1) E rectangle; pin in place. Stitch diagonally across D square. Trim to a ¼" seam allowance and press toward E. Repeat for opposite end of E, as shown. Make (4) Flying Geese units.








4. Sew (1) Flying Geese unit from Step 3 to (1) F rectangle; press toward Flying Geese unit. Make (4) Unit #2.





5. Lay out Unit #1's, Unit #2's, and G square, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press open) to create the Starz block measuring 6 1/2" square.
