

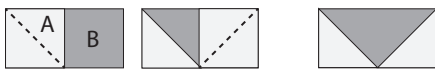
Block 39: Framed Star - Jo Morton

Use (1) light, (1) medium, and (1) dark fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

- A - (24) squares, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" (LIGHT)
- B - (12) rectangles, 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" (MEDIUM)
- C - (8) squares, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" (DARK)
- D - (1) square, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (LIGHT)

Assembly

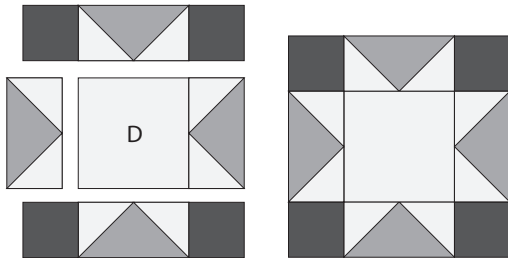
1. Layer (1) A square on one end of (1) B rectangle; pin in place. Stitch diagonally across A square. Trim corner to a 1/4" seam allowance and press toward B. Repeat for opposite end of B, as shown. Make (12) Flying Geese units.



2. Sew (2) C squares to (1) Flying Geese unit from Step 1; press toward C's. Make (2) strips.



3. Sew (2) Flying Geese units from Step 1 to sides of (1) D square, as shown; press toward D. Sew strips from Step 2 to top and bottom (press seams open) to make Unit #1.

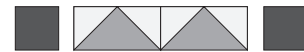


Unit #1

4. Sew together (2) Flying Geese units (from Step 1) to make a Flying Geese strip. Make (2) Unit #2. Sew (2) more Flying Geese units together and add (2) D squares. Make (2) Unit #3.

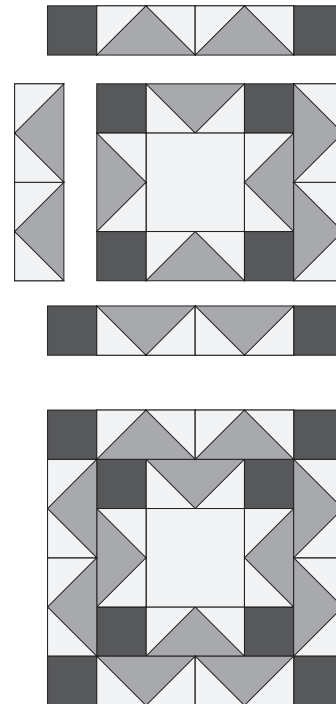

5. Lay out Unit #1, Unit #2's, and Unit #3's, as shown. Sew Unit #2's to sides of Unit #1; press toward Unit #2's. Sew Unit #3's to top and bottom (press toward Unit #3's) to create the Framed Star block measuring 6 1/2" square.
