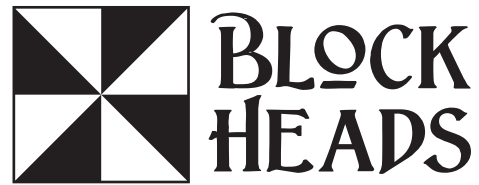

Block 43: Any Direction - Kansas Troubles Quilters, Lynne Hagmeier, Designer


Use (1) dark and (1) light, and (1) medium fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

KT Layered Patchwork


A - (1) square, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"  (DARK #1)


B - (8) rectangles, 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" (LIGHT)

C - (1) square, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"  (DARK #2)

D - (4) squares, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"  (DARK)

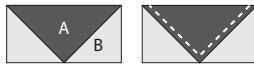
E - (5) squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (LIGHT)

 = cut once diagonally, corner to corner

 = cut twice diagonally, corner to corner

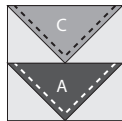
Assembly

1. Layer (1) A triangle on (1) B rectangle, right sides up and aligning top edges; glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edge of A triangle with coordinating cotton thread. Make (4) A/B Flying Geese units.

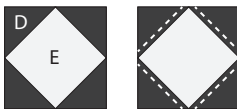


2. Repeat the process using (1) C triangle on (1) B rectangle to make (4) C/B Flying Geese units.

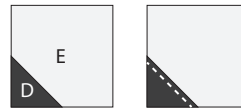
3. Sew (1) A/B unit from Step 1 to (1) C/B unit from Step 2, as shown. Press toward A/B. Make (4) pieced units.



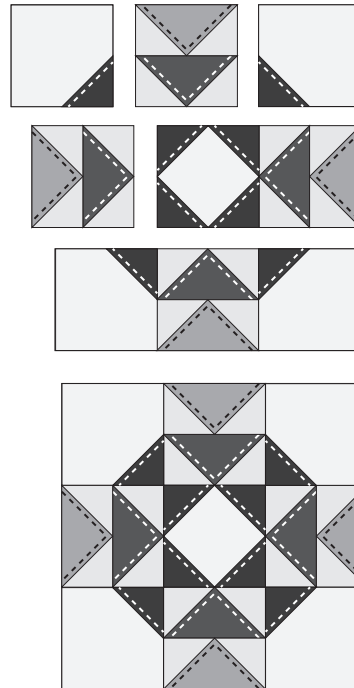
4. Layer (4) D triangles on (1) E square, aligning corners, gluing in place, and top stitching 1/8" from bias edges, as shown. Make (1).



5. Layer (1) D triangle on (1) E square, aligning corners, gluing in place, and top stitching 1/8" from bias edges, as shown. Make (4).



6. Lay out pieced units from Steps 3, 4 and 5. Sew into rows; press each row toward Step 4 and 5 units. Sew rows together (press open) to create the Any Direction block measuring 6 1/2" square.

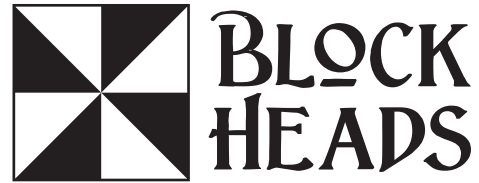

Block 43: Any Direction - Kansas Troubles Quilters, Lynne Hagmeier, Designer

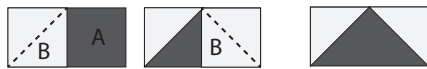
Use (1) dark and (1) light, and (1) medium fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

KT Traditional Patchwork

- A - (4) rectangles, 2" x 3½" (DARK #1)
- B - (16) squares, 2" x 2" (LIGHT)
- C - (4) rectangles, 2" x 3½" (DARK #2)
- D - (8) squares, 1 ½" x 1 ½" (DARK)
- E - (5) squares, 2 ½" x 2 ½" (LIGHT)

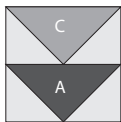
Assembly

1. Layer (1) B square on one end of (1) A rectangle; pin in place. Stitch diagonally across B square. Trim to a ¼" seam allowance and press toward B. Repeat for opposite end of A, as shown. Make (4) Flying Geese units.



2. Repeat the process using (8) B squares on (4) C rectangles to make (4) C/B Flying Geese units.

3. Sew (1) A/B unit from Step 1 to (1) C/B unit from Step 2, as shown. Press toward A/B. Make (4) pieced units.



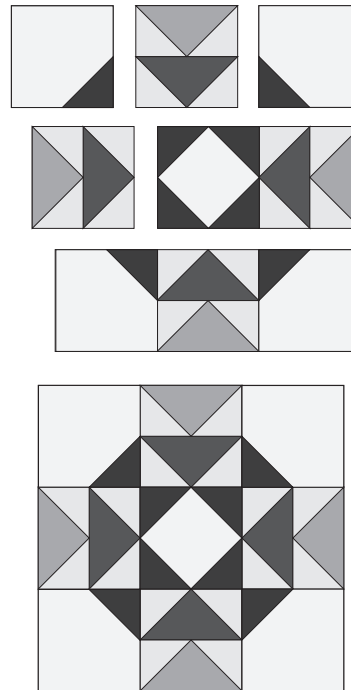
4. Layer (1) D square on (1) E square, aligning corners. Stitch diagonally across the D square. Trim to a ¼" seam allowance and press toward D. Repeat in the remaining three corners. Make (1).



5. Layer (1) D square on (1) E square, aligning corners. Stitch diagonally across the D square. Make (4). Trim to a ¼" seam allowance and press toward D. Make (4) units.



6. Lay out the pieced units from Steps 3, 4 and 5. Sew into rows; press each row away from flying geese units. Sew rows together (press open) to create the Any Direction block measuring 6 ½" square.



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
