



Block 47: Starry 9-Patch - Lisa Bongean

Use (1) medium, (1) light, and (1) dark fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

- A (4) squares, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " (MEDIUM)
- B (4) squares, 1 ½" x 1 ½" (LIGHT)
- C (1) square, 1 ½" x 1 ½" (DARK)
 - D (2) squares, 2 ¾" x 2 ¾" ⊠ (MEDIUM)
- E (2) squares, 2 ¾" x 2 ¾" ⋈ (DARK)
 - F (1) square, 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" ⊠ (LIGHT)
 - G (4) squares, 2" x 2" (LIGHT)
- \square = cut twice diagonally from corner to corner

- Assembly
- 1. Sew (2) A squares to (1) B square; press toward A's. Make (2) strips.



2. Sew (2) B squares to (1) C square; press toward C. Set strips from Step 1 to top and bottom (press toward center strip) to make Unit #1.



3. Sew (1) D triangle to (1) E triangle, as shown; press toward D. Make (4) Unit #2a. Repeat process changing the orientation of E. Make (4) Unit #2b.












4. Sew (1) Unit #2a and (1) Unit #2b from Step 3 to the short sides of (1) F triangle. Make (4) pieced Flying Geese units.





5. Lay out Unit #1, (4) pieced Flying Geese units from Step 4, and (4) G squares, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press open) to create the Starry 9-Patch block measuring 6 1/2" square.
