Block 47: Starry 9-Patch - Lisa Bongean
Use (1) medium, (1) light, and (1) dark fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

A - (4) squares, $1 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " (MEDIUM)
B - (4) squares, $1 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 "}{} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " (LIGHT)
C - (1) square, $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (DARK)
D - (2) squares, $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 4$ " $\boxtimes$ (MEDIUM)

- E-(2) squares, $23 / 44^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 44^{\prime \prime}$ 凹 (DARK)

G - (4) squares, 2" x 2" (LIGHT)
- $\boxtimes=$ cut twice diagonally from corner to corner
- Assembly

1. Sew (2) A squares to (1) B square; press toward A's. Make (2) strips.

2. Sew (2) B squares to (1) C square; press toward C. Set strips from Step 1 to top and bottom (press toward center strip) to make Unit \#1.

. Sew (1) D triangle to (1) E triangle, as shown; press toward D. Make (4) Unit \#2a. Repeat process changing the orientation of E. Make (4) Unit \#2b.


Unit \#1
4. Sew (1) Unit \#2a and (1) Unit \#2b from Step 3 to the short sides of (1) F triangle. Make (4) pieced Flying Geese units.

5. Lay out Unit \#1, (4) pieced Flying Geese units from Step 4, and (4) G squares, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press open) to create the Starry 9 -Patch block measuring $61 / 2$ " square.


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
