



## Block 48: Honeymoon - Carrie Nelson

Use (1) light, (2) dark, and (2) medium fabrics. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

- A (4) squares, 1 %" x 1 %" (LIGHT)
- B (4) squares, 1 %" x 1 %" (DARK#1)
- C (4) squares, 1 ½" x 1 ½" (LIGHT)
  - D (4) squares, 1 ½" x 1 ½" (MEDIUM #1)
- E (2) squares, 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" ⊠ (DARK #2)
  - F (1) square, 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" ⊠ (LIGHT)
  - G (1) square, 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" 🛛 (MEDIUM #1)
- H (1) square, 2 ½" x 2 ½" (MEDIUM #2)
  - $\boxtimes$  = cut twice diagonally, corner to corner

## Assembly

1. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of (1) A square and place on (1) B square; pin in place. Stitch a ¼" seam allowance on each side of drawn line. Cut in half and press pieced squares toward B. Make (8).









2. Sew together (1) C square, (2) pieced squares from Step 1, and (1) D square, as shown; press toward pieced squares and press center seam open. Make (4) Unit #1.





Unit #1

3. Sew (1) E triangle to (1) F triangle; press toward E. make 4 pieced triangles.







4. Repeat Step 3 using (1) E triangle and (1) G triangle; press toward E. Make 4 pieced triangles.







5. Sew (1) Step 3 pieced triangle to (1) Step 4 pieced triangle. Make (4) Unit #2.






6. Lay out Unit #1's, Unit #2's, and H square, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press open) to create the Honeymoon block measuring 6 ½" square.
