Block #4 - Bee Skep by Jan Patek STRIP-PIECED APPLIQUE OPTION BY KTQ, LYNNE HAGMEIER

KT STRIP-PIECED APPLIQUE

Assorted Golds - (10) 1 ½" x 5"
LIGHT - applique foundation - 6" sq.
Tan - background - 7" sq.
Black - bee skep opening - 1 ¼" sq.
Brown - bee skep stand - 1 ½" x 5"
Fusible Web
Cotton Thread - gold, brown, black

ASSEMBLY

- 1. Draw the outline of Jan's Bee Skep from the original pattern onto muslin or light colored fabric. Cut around drawn lines leaving at least 1/4".
- 2. Fold and press 10 gold strips in half widthwise to equal 3/4" x 5" each. Position folded edge of first strip on bottom line of bee skep. Stitch 1/4" from cut edges of strip thru foundation.
- 3. Continue layering strips onto foundation with cut edges of strips about 1/4" above bee skep lines. Cover bee skep with (10) strips of gold fabric.
- 4. Cut out bee skep shape on drawn lines.
- 5. Trace bee skep opening and stand onto fusible web. Fuse bee skep opening to black fabric and bee skep stand to brown fabric. Cut on drawn lines; remove paper backing.
- 6. Position bee skep, stand and opening on tan back-ground square; fuse/pin in place. Blanketstitch with matching cotton thread around applique motifs. Trim background to 6 ½" square.

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
