

Block HEADS

Block 5: Coronation - Lisa Bongean
Use (1) light and (1) dark fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

A - (5) squares, $15 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 1$ 5/8" (LIGHT)
B - (5) squares, $15 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 1$ 5/8" (DARK)
C - (14) squares, $1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ (LIGHT)
D - (8) squares, $1 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{11 / 4 " ~(D A R K) ~}{4 \prime \prime}$
E - (4) rectangles, $1 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 " ~}{} \times 2$ " (LIGHT)
F - (8) squares, 2" x 2" (DARK)
G - (4) rectangles, 2" x 3 ½" (LIGHT)

## Assembly

1. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of (1) A square and place it on (1) B square; pin in place. Stitch a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance on each side of drawn line. Cut in half and press pieced squares toward B. Make (10).
2. Sew (2) pieced squares from Step 1 to (2) C squares, as shown; press toward pieced squares and press center seam open. Make (5) FourPatch units.
3. Layer (1) D square on one end of (1) E rectangle; pin in place. Stitch diagonally across D square. Trim corner to a $1 / 4 /$ seam allowance and press toward D. Repeat for opposite end of E, as shown. Make (4) Flying Geese units.


4. Repeat Step 3 using (2) F squares and (1) G rectangle. Make (4) Unit \#2.


Unit \#2
6. Lay out (4) Four-Patch units from Step 2, Unit \#1, and Unit \#2's. Sew into rows; press rows in opposite directions. Sew rows together (press seams open) to create the Coronation block measuring $61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square.
