



4. Lay out Unit #1's, Unit #2's, and E square, as shown. Sew into rows; press each row in opposite direction. Sew rows

together (press open) to create the Ohio Star Variation

Block 9: Ohio Star Variation - Jo Morton


Use (1) dark and (1) light fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

- A (8) squares, 1 ½" x 1 ½" (DARK)
- B (8) squares, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " (LIGHT)
- C (2) squares, 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" (LIGHT)
 - D (2) squares, 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" (DARK)
- E (1) square, 2 ½" x 2 ½" (DARK)

Assembly

Unit #2.

1. Sew (2) A squares and (2) B squares together into strips, as shown; press toward A. Sew the strips together and




















block measuring 6 1/2" square.






















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
