






C		2120Q-X pastel/multi	1/8	• See instruction to cut one of each shape C-1 through C-3.
D		2128Q-X light rose	1/8	• See instruction to cut one of each shape D-1, D-2, D-3 and D-4.
E		2127Q-X cyan	1/8	• See instruction to cut one of each shape E-1, E-2, E-3, E-4 and E-5.
F		100Q-1635 marina	1/4	• See instruction to cut one of each shape F-1 through F-9.
G		2121Q-X blush	1/8	• See instruction to cut one of each shape G-1 through G-20.
H		2131Q-X sangria	1/4	• See instruction to cut one of each shape H-1 through H-6.

N		100Q-1907 trippy	1/8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instruction to cut one of each shape N-1, N-2, N-3, N-4 and N-5.
O		2122Q-X sangria	1/8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instruction to cut one of each shape O-1, O-2, O-3, O-4 and O-5.
P		100Q-1502 purple haze	1/8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instruction to cut one of each shape P-1 and P-2.
Q		2129Q-X petal	1/8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instruction to cut one of each shape Q-1, Q-2, Q-3 and Q-4.
R		100Q-1679 midnight	2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut one 38" x 50-1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strip. • Cut five 2-1/2" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strips for the binding.
S		100Q-1046 white	1/8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See instruction to cut one of each shape S-1 through S-27.
		Backing 2131Q-X sangria	2-3/4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (2) 46" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 46" x 58" to make the back.
		You will also need:		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Batting 59" x 71" • Fusible web



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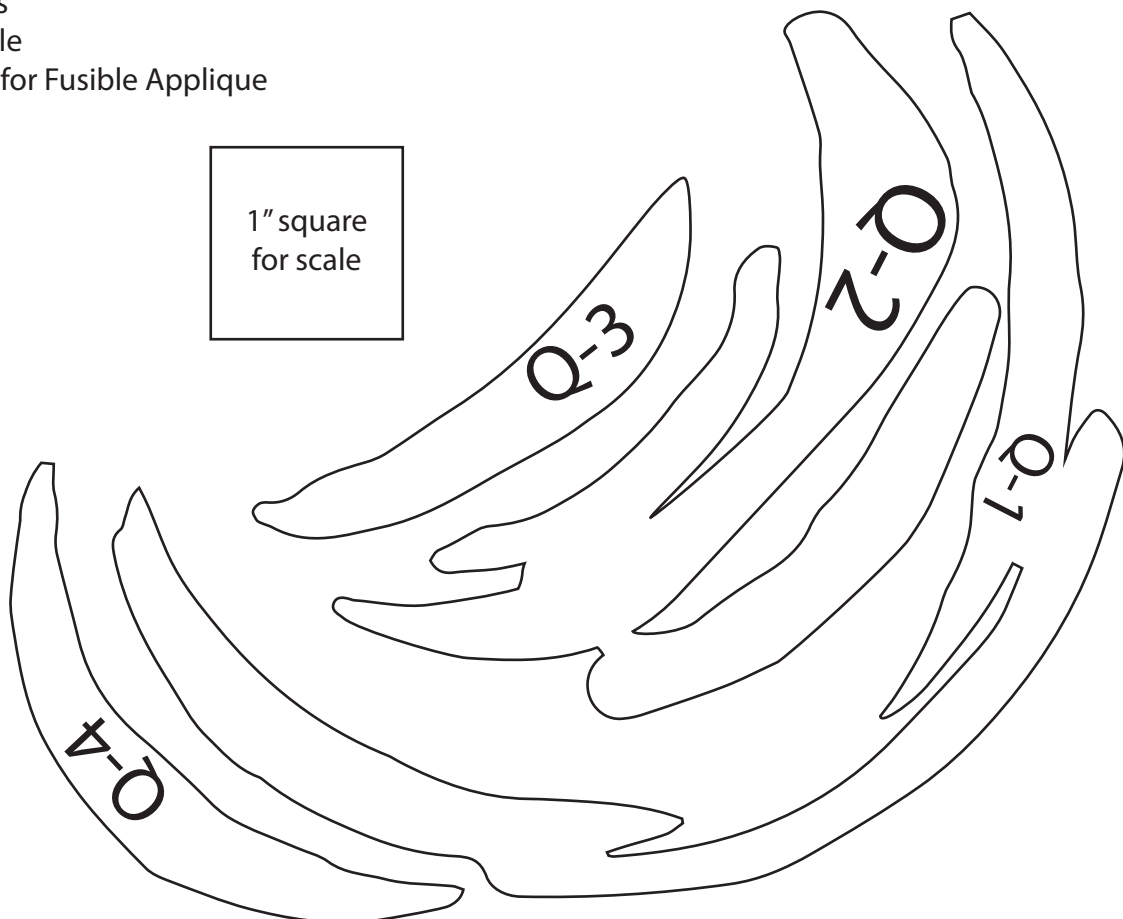
Quilt Top Assembly – *Refer to the Quilt Layout on Page 4 while assembling the quilt top:*

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template including the fabric color and part number onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Press the 38" x 50-1/2" Fabric **R** rectangle in half both ways and press to mark the background center line.
4. Refer to the quilt layout and use the white center lines as a guide to arrange and press the assorted flowers and leaves onto the Fabric **R** background. Use the part numbers as a guide for placement.
5. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.

Finishing

6. Layer and quilt as desired.
7. Sew the (5) 2-1/2" x WOF Fabric **R** strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
8. Bind as desired.
