
Stuffed Spring Carrots




Materials:


1-10" square cotton fabric
Polyfil stuffing
coordinating ribbon or twine
artificial greenery for carrot top
buttons or other decorations
glue gun
pinking shears
sewing machine
rule and rotary cutter


Fold 10" square in half, right sides together (RST)






Place ruler diagonally, corner to corner and trim. Sew along the cut edge using a ¼ seam. Start at the point using a back stitch.





Turn right-side out. Trim top edge of fabric with pinking shears.



Stuff with polyfil stuffing to desired firmness. Insert greenery into the top and tie off with ribbon or twine. You can use hot glue to help keep the greenery in place. Try using different materials for greenery or add buttons, charms, etc...
