CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

A: Animal Blocks-Black and Cream (20968-21), cut:

- (5) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (25) 6 1/2" squares.

B: Dots-Cream (20967-21), cut:

- (10) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (40) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips.

C: Dots-Multi (20967-11), cut:

- (13) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (100) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

D: Dots-Dark Orange (20967 17), to

- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (23) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.

E: Animal and Vines-Orange (20964 18), to

- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (23) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.

F: Dots-Blue (20967 12), to

- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (23) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.

G: Park Patches-Light Blue (20965 14), to

- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (23) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.

H: Animal and Vines-Green (20964 16), to

- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.

I: Binding (Your Choice)






- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

J: Backing

- (2) 62 1/2" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62 1/2" x 62 1/2" back.



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Sew (1) 1 1/2" square Fabric F on each side of (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" fabric (C) strip to make the top and bottom row.
2. Repeat Steps 1 to make (50) Unit strips total. See illustrations for quantity, fabric and color placement.



3. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" square Fabric F on each side of (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" fabric (C) strip to make the side rows.




4. Repeat Step 3 to make (50) Unit strips total. See illustrations for quantity, fabric and color placement.







5. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to top and bottom of (1) 6 1/2 Fabric A square (letter "A") to make the middle row. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2 Fabric A square (letter "A") to make (1) 8 1/2" unfinished and 8" finished Block square.

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to component identification, placement and orientation to make the remaining (24) Units.

Note: There will be (25) Block squares total.



6. Sew (1) 1 1/2" square in between (5) 1 1/2"X 8 1/2" strips fabric (B) . Create (4) rows using the diagram below for fabric and color placement.



QUILT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

7. Sew (1) 1 1/2" X 8 1/2" strips fabric B between each letter block. Create (5) rows using the diagram below for fabric and letter placement.
8. Sew all the rows together to create a 44 1/2" x 44 1/2" square.
9. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric B to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric H strips together end-to-end with 45-degree seams to make the
