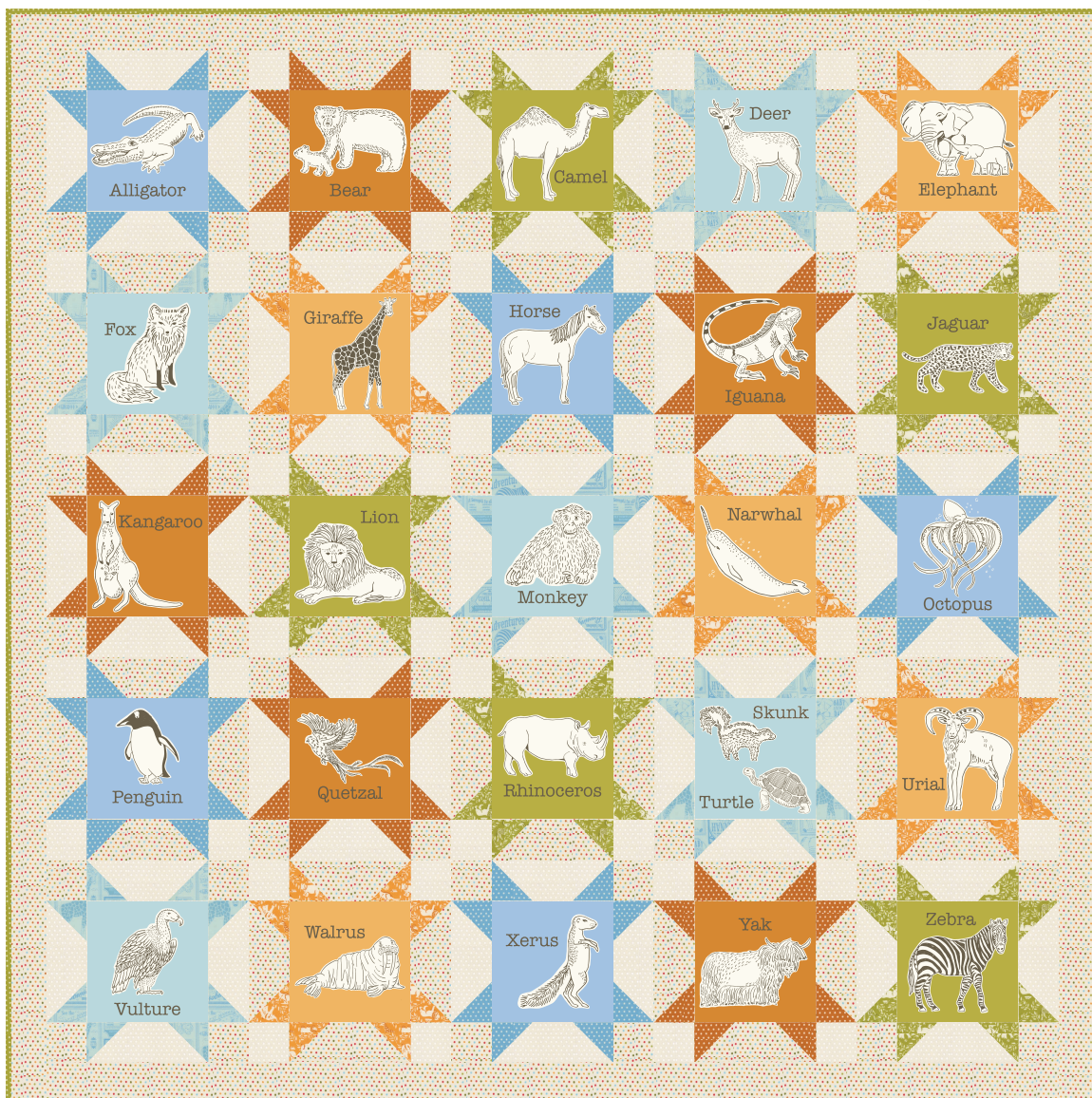


SHINING STAR QUILT

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

A: Animal Blocks-Multi (20969 11), cut:

- (5) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (25) 6 1/2" squares.

B: Dots-Cream (20967-21), cut:

- (9) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (52) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (52) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

C: Dots-Multi (20967-11), cut:

- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.

D: Dots-Dark Orange (20967 17), to

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (40) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

E: Animal and Vines-Orange (20964 18), to

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (40) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

F: Dots-Blue (20967 12), to

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (40) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

G: Park Patches-Light Blue (20965 14), to

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (40) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

H: Animal and Vines-Green (20964 16), to

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (40) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

I: Binding (Your Choice)

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

J: Backing

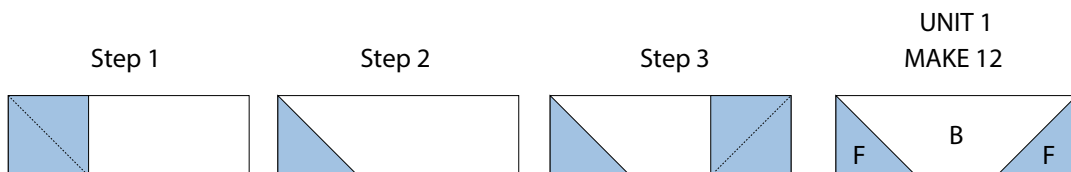
- (2) 62 1/2" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62 1/2" x 62 1/2" back.

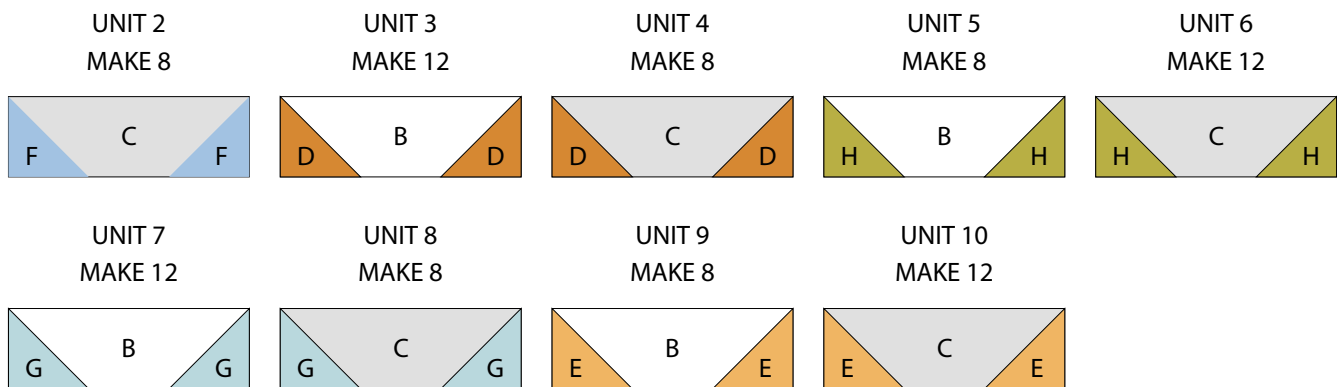
INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric F square on the left side of (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Step 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Step 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 5).

2. Place another 2 1/2" Fabric F square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Step 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Step 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip.

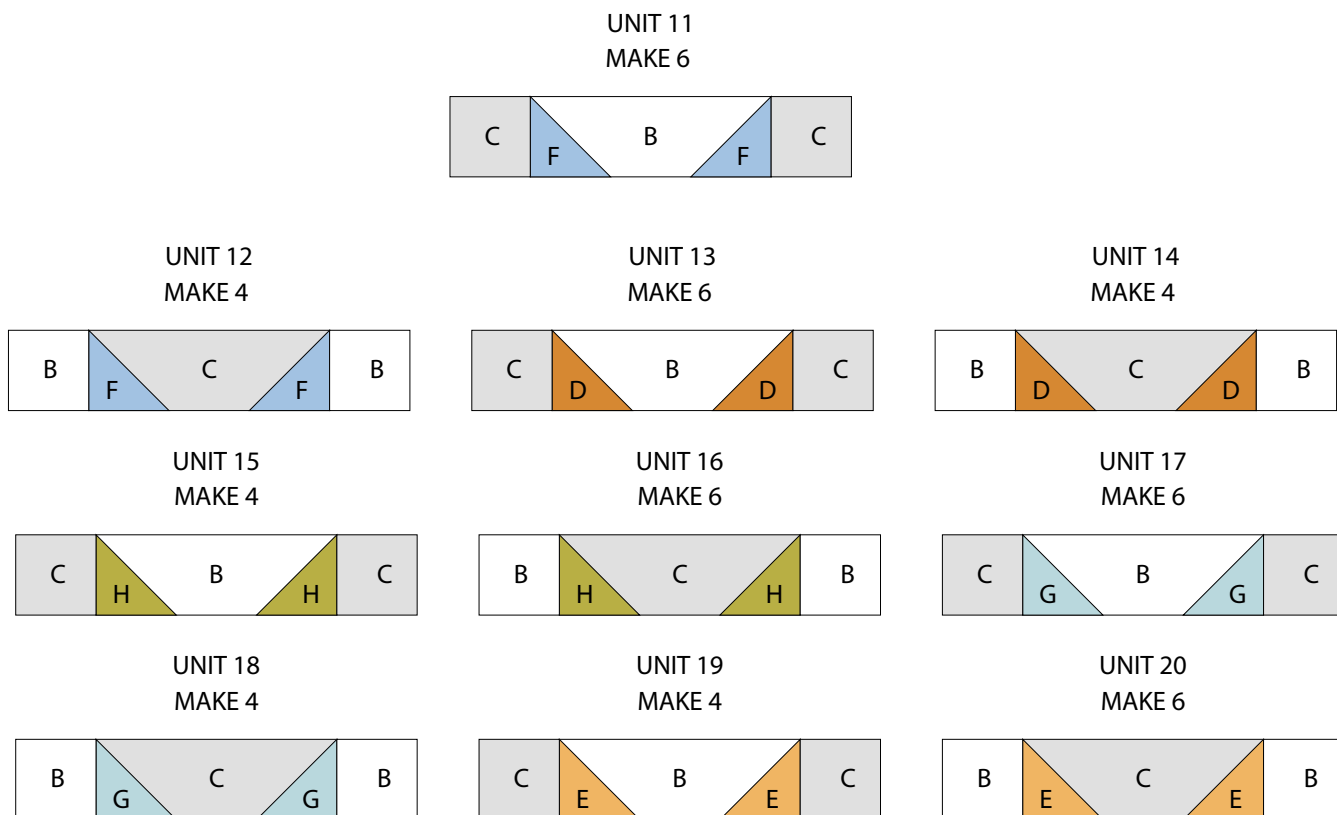
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (100) Unit strips total. See illustrations for quantity, fabric and color placement.





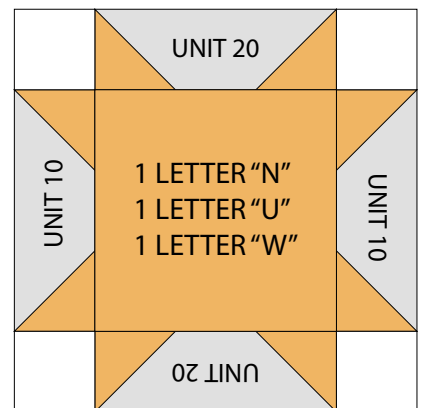
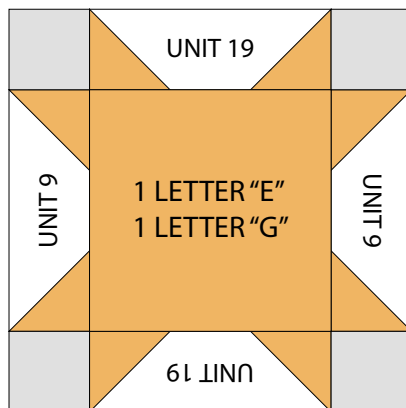
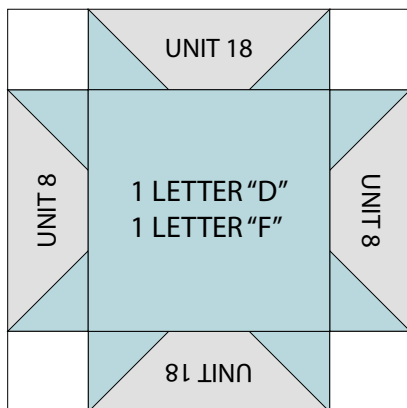
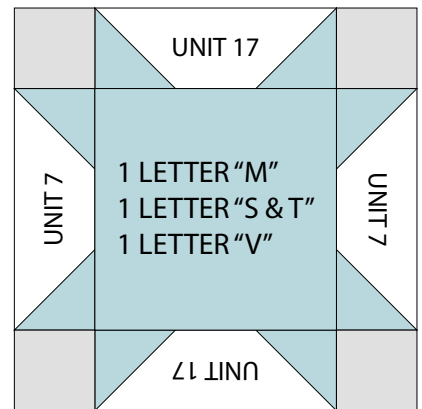
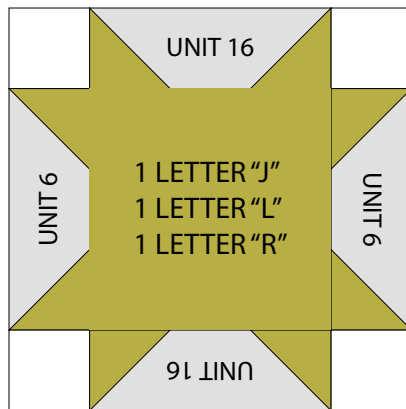
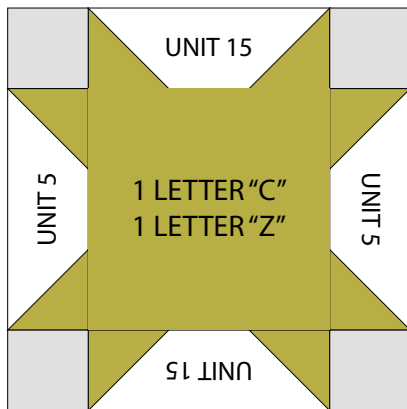
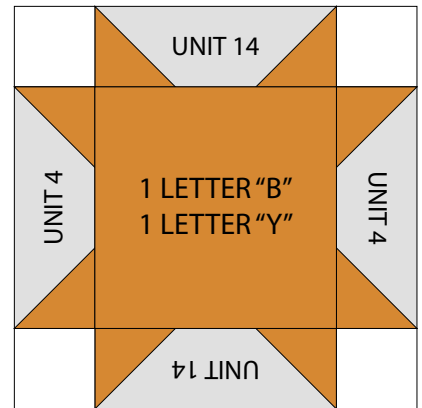
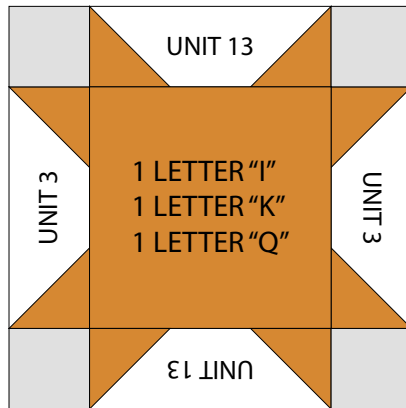
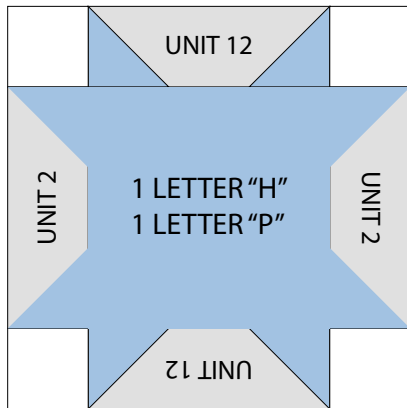
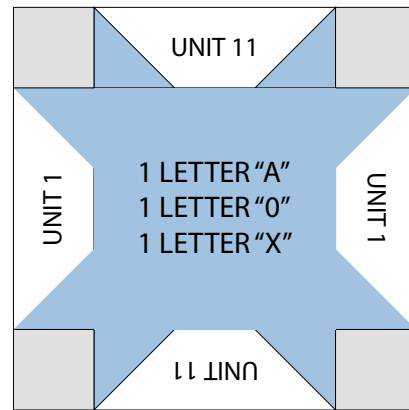
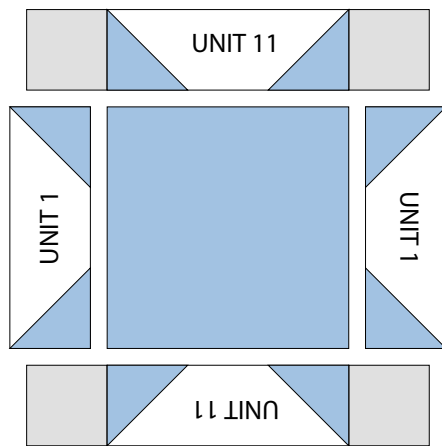
4. Sew (1) 2 1/2" square Fabric C on each side of Unit 1 strip to make the top row.

5. Repeat Step 4 to make (50) Unit strips total. See illustrations for quantity, fabric and color placement.



6. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2 Fabric A square (letter "A") to make the middle row. Sew (1) Unit 11 strip to bottom and top of (1) 6 1/2 Fabric A square (letter "A") to make (1) 10 1/2" unfinished and 10" finished Block square.

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to component identification, placement and orientation to make the remaining (24) Units. Note: There will be (25) Block squares total.



QUILT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

7. Sew together (5) blocks to create row according to image below.
8. Sew the rows together to create a 50 1/2" x 50 1/2" square.
9. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 50 1/2" Fabric C to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric H strips together end-to-end with 45-degree seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
12. Bind as desired.
