

One Block Wonder using Panels

Student Prerequisites:

Must have a working knowledge of your sewing machine, sewing/quilting experience, how to use a rotary cutter and ruler. Accurate cutting skills and piecing skills.

Please iron all fabrics before class.

Student Supply list:

One Block Wonders of the World by Maxine Rosenthal and Linda Bardes
45 or 60 mm Rotary Cutter with a **new blade** (will be cutting through 6 layers of fabric)
Cutting Mat - at least 18x24
60-degree ruler
6 x 24-inch ruler
Flower Pins or pins with a flat head
Sewing machine in good working order
Thread
Design wall or equivalent

You will need 7 panels of the same design. Fabric should not have too many colors.

Refer to book for advice on picking fabric or come to the shop for help.

Fabric for border. It is best to buy this after the center of the quilt is finished

Fabric for backing and binding. It is also best to buy this after the quilt top is finished.

***Optional - Fabric for tumbling blocks: 1/3 yard of 3 different contrasting fabrics if you want tumbling blocks to pop or 1/3 yard of 3 different coordinating fabrics if you want tumbling blocks to blend.
