Famore Rotary Cutter—We are using the 60mm rotary cutter at the front counter. It rolls very easy because of the ball bearings. Come in and test drive one of these great cutters.

New Quilted Lining—This 6oz quilted lining is quilted with Ulus, Caribou & Polar Bears. We also have a lining ordered with Arctic flowers and is very colorful. The Ulu lining is coming in a variety of colors.

Bias Tape by Brador—These bias tapes are poly/cotton and match their quilted parka linings.

Quilting Cuddle—New shorter nap designed for adding to your quilting projects. They have very little stretch but great colors.

Marshmallow Cuddle—Marshmallow Cuddle® is an ultra-soft, 4-way-stretch minky fabric, offering a unique, stretchy, and marshmallow like texture. Think of stretch Velour. This plush fabric is perfect for apparel, plushies, accent pillows, sheets and more!

Hamburger Potato Casserole

This is a recipe that even finicky eaters will like. With layers of ground beef, creamy sauce, and tender potatoes, it's kid-friendly comfort food everyone loves.

Prep Time: 20 mins

Cook Time: 1 hour 20 min

Total Time: 1 hour 40 mins

Servings: 6

Ingredients

1 pound lean ground beef

- 1 (10.5 ounce) can condensed cream of mushroom soup
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup milk
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup chopped onion
- salt and ground black pepper to taste
- 3 cups peeled and thinly sliced potatoes
- 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese

Directions

1. Gather all ingredients. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F
2. Heat a large skillet over medium-high heat. Cook and stir ground beef in the hot skillet until browned and crumbly, 5-7 minutes. Drain and discard grease.
3. Mix condensed soup, milk, onion, salt, and pepper in a medium bowl until combined.
4. Alternately layer the potatoes, soup mixture, and browned ground beef in a 2-quart baking dish. Cover dish tightly with foil.
5. Bake in the preheated oven until potatoes are tender, about 1 to 1.5 hours.
6. Remove foil, sprinkle Cheddar cheese on top, and continue baking until cheese is melted and bubbly, 5 to 10 minutes.
7. Serve and enjoy.

Cook's Note

You can use cream of chicken or celery soup instead of mushroom.
