Passover Unstuffed Cabbage Soup

Prep Time: 20 Min Cook Time: 2 hrs 10mins Total Time: 2 hrs 30 min

Servings: 8 Yield: 8 Servings

Ingredients:

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 yellow onion, chopped
- 3 cups water
- 2 cups tomato sauce
- 1 (16 ounce) package shredded white cabbage
- ¼ cup light brown sugar, packed
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons white vinegar
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 2 teaspoons white sugar
- 1 teaspoon ground black pepper
- ½ teaspoon onion powder

Directions:

- 1. Heat oil in a pot over medium-high heat. Cook and stir ground beef and onion in hot oil until beef is browned and crumbly and onion is soft, 7 to 10 minutes.
- 2. Stir water, tomato sauce, cabbage, brown sugar, lemon juice, vinegar, salt, white sugar, black pepper, and onion powder into ground beef mixture. Bring to a boil, reduce heat to medium-low, cover the pot with a lid, and simmer until flavors combine and cabbage is tender, at least 2 hours
