Shop Policies with COVID-19—We are open and ready to help you with all of your sewing and quilting needs. Masks are highly recommended but optional. Class Sale Day—Sign up for Classes on August 22 and January 2. Those signing up for classes will receive a 20% discount on supplies. You can always sign up earlier and get a 15% discount on your class supplies.

1st Saturday BOM—September 12 we start a new BOM by Krista Moser called Fanfaire. There will be several options to this quilt. Watch for more information about this beautiful quilt. It is hanging in the shop right behind the front counter. If you decide to take the full kit, it will be \$22/mo. That does not include the book and ruler. I hope you can join us. The blocks go together so quickly I was able to make 6 blocks in one weekend, sewing only part time. I hope you will join us here at the shop or on Facebook Live.

Zoom Classes—We tried our first Zoom class in July and we had a great time. Our next Zoom class will start Oct. 22, 29, & Nov 5, 12:15-12:45pm. You will get a recap of the class after each lesson. “Perfection is Overrated” will be the emphasis of this class, using a pattern by Cut Loose Press. Class is \$15.

What's New

Seam Guide Rulers from Creative Grids—

These 1/2” by 15 & 1/2” x 9.5” seam marking tools are long enough to mark diagonals through 10” and 6.5” squares. Uses grippers on the back to prevent sliding.

3-in-1 Face Mask Template by Creative

Grids—This new template makes it easy to make small, medium or large face masks with two coordinating fabrics. Pattern included.

Fabric Panels by Stephanie Richey—This local artist has put several of her watercolor paintings onto fabric. These panels are beautiful and waiting to be used in a project. Check them out!

Tote Bag for Featherweight —

These canvas totes are perfect for carrying a featherweight or small sewing machine. They measure 14.5” x 12” x 8.5”

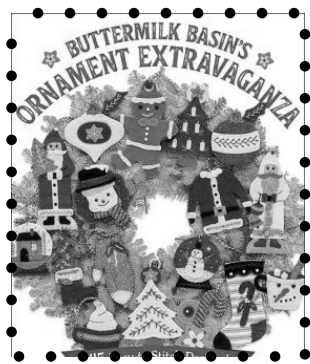

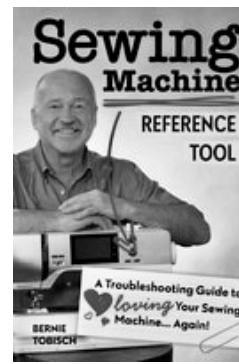
