What's New

Oliso Mini Iron with Trivet—This new iron from Oliso is perfect for your sewing area. It is small, fits in your hand, but has the power of a larger iron. We are hoping to see it soon.

Round Rotary Cutting Mat—This mat is easy to rotate so you can cut pieces without shifting the fabrics. The base is a Lazy Susan with ball bearings so it rotates easily and smoothly.

Velocity Compact Vapor Generator Iron—We love this iron here at the shop. It is heavy, has a powerful steam but generates the steam in a new way so less likely that it will “spit” on your fabrics. Just ask us!

Felted Wool Pressing Mat— These are great when you want a better press to your project or seams. They are available in different sizes.

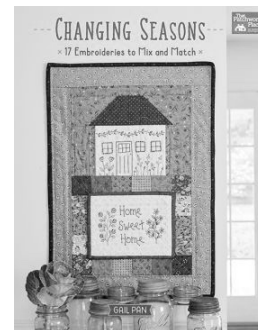
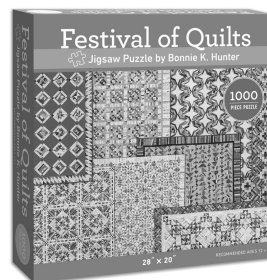

Perfect Summer Fruit Salad

10 Servings

Ingredients:

- 2/3 cup fresh orange juice
- 1/3 cup fresh lemon juice
- 1/3 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon grated orange zest
- 1/2 teaspoon grated lemon zest
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups cubed fresh pineapple
- 2 cups strawberries, hulled and sliced
- 3 kiwi fruit, peeled and sliced
- 3 bananas, sliced
- 2 oranges, peeled and sectioned
- 1 cup seedless grapes
- 2 cups blueberries

Prep: 25 m Cook: 5 m Ready In: 3 h 30 m

1. Bring orange juice, lemon juice, brown sugar, orange zest, and lemon zest to a boil in a saucepan over medium-high heat. Reduce heat to medium-low, and simmer until slightly thickened, about 5 minutes. Remove from heat, and stir in vanilla extract. Set aside to cool.
2. Layer the fruit in a large, clear glass bowl in this order: pineapple, strawberries, kiwi fruit, bananas, oranges, grapes, and blueberries. Pour the cooled sauce over the fruit. Cover and refrigerate for 3 to 4 hours before serving.
