Longer Days—I love this time of year as the days get longer and we look forward to spring. We have some really exciting classes planned for you. Read On!

Color Me Happy BOM-- Fun, fun, fun is all I can say. This BOM started Sept 8 at 9am or 10am and meets each month on the first Saturday of the month. Color Me Happy includes 12 blocks using only 5" squares as the base. Each block will use the same background and the rest will be scrappy. Only \$5 a month. It's not too late to sign up and join us each month.

Class Sale Day—Sign up for Classes on December 29 and April 27. Those signing up for classes will receive a 20% discount on supplies. You can always sign up earlier and get a 15% discount on your class supplies.

Kimberbell Class with Alicia—Alicia will be offering a new seasonal project from one of the Kimberbell books each quarter. These are wonderful classes and kits are always available. We can't keep them in the shop. Sign up for this early!

Open Late Monday Night till 7pm!—Several people work in Anchorage and cannot get to the shop before we close at 5pm. So, on Monday night, starting in January, we will stay open till 7pm. Stop by on your way home from work.

Open Sew--Join us Wednesdays and/or Fridays for a time to sew with others. Work on your own project. No instruction available. Potluck on Fridays. Starts at 9:00.

Women of the Bible BOM—This will challenge you to be "on your game" and me as well. This is a **FREE BOM** that started in October. The catch...you have to be signed up on our email list and you have to open the email. Join at any time and purchase a complete program at the end of the 40 blocks for \$20.

Night-time Open Sew—On the 4th Friday of the month, January through April, we will be staying open late for those of you who want to have an opportunity to sew with other. We will be open from 5:00-8:30 and the fee for this is \$10. Bring your projects and sew into the night.

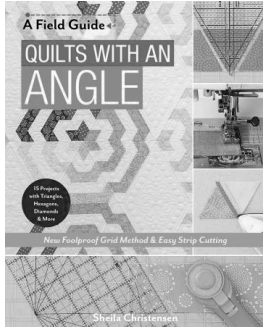

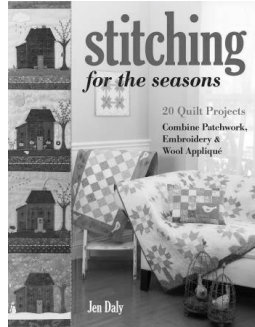
