New Rotary Cutting Mats from Creative Grids—Look for them right after January 1st. They will be better than most mats on the market, in a grey with aqua lines. We are very excited for these to arrive.

Cordless Iron—Two styles are available. They work great and sit in a base to get recharged. They stay hot a long time and are pointed on each end to get into tight spots. Check them out!

Silicone Iron Rest—This colorful iron rest resists heat. Great place to rest your iron and especially when it is cooling down.

Zipper by the Yard— 5 yard zipper rolls with lots of pulls in the package. They are available in a variety of colors. Need help using them? Ask us! Great when making bags using different size zippers.

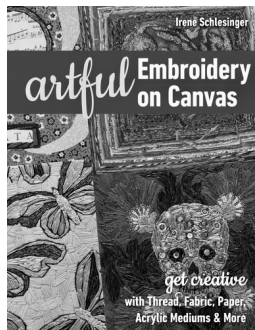
