What:

Why:

Spread some holiday cheer, have fun stitching, and get entered to win a \$100 gift card along with two other prizes of staff favorite notions from the Twin Falls Sewing Center.

How:

Print out the free Stockings for Santa pattern. Stitch up a stocking using the pattern. Please do not resize the pattern. Your stocking must include your first name somewhere on the front of the stocking, but the rest is up to you!

Get creative - add appliqué, decorative stitches, quilting, machine embroidery, etc. to make your stocking uniquely you!

Bring your stocking in to the store, along with the completed tag attached or placed inside the stocking and receive a coupon for 25% off one notion of your choice along with a raffle ticket that will be entered into the grand prize drawing. *Only one entry per person.

Prizes will be drawn December 20, 2022 on Facebook Live and you do not need to be present to win. *You will be able to pick up your stocking anytime on or after January 2, 2023.

Basic Supplies Needed:

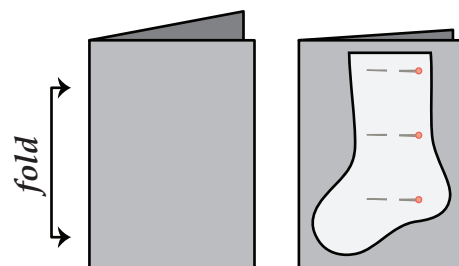
- (1) 12" x 18" piece of fabric for the main body of your stocking
- General Sewing Supplies such as sewing machine, pins, thread, scissors, etc.
- Anything else for customizing your stocking.

A Few Notes:

*Please print pattern at 100% scale before starting. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise directed. This is not a lined stocking. Note: Depending on the techniques and style of stocking you are creating you may want to start by prepping, quilting, etc. your stocking fabric before cutting out and sewing the stocking together.

Fold main fabric in half wrong sides together, place pattern on top, pin and cut out.



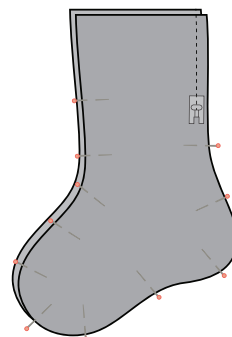

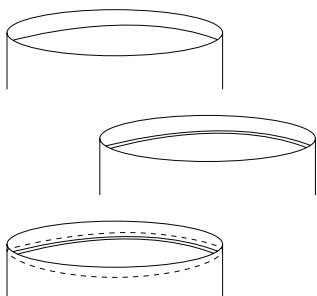
Customize stocking and add name to the front of stocking.

Place stocking right sides together and stitch along the perimeter leaving the top open. Turn right side out and press.

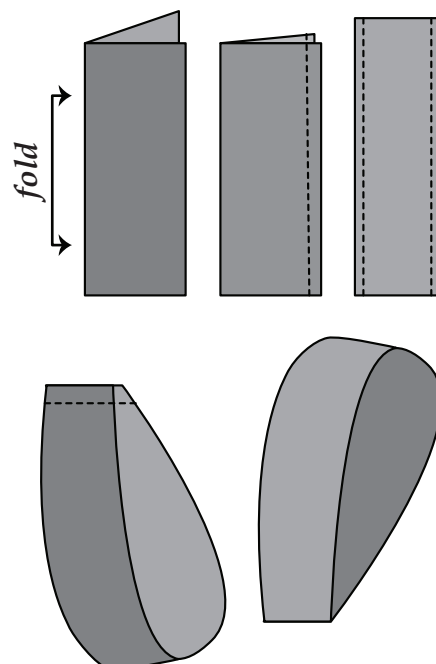


Take top edge and fold 1/4" down and press, then fold another 1/4" down and press. Topstitch edge.

Optional Hanging Loop: (1) 2" x 3" scrap of fabric

- Fold in half lengthwise, right sides together and press.
- Stitch with a 1/4" seam allowance along the unfinished edge
- Turn right side out and press with seam towards the center back or edge.
- Fold loop in half, right sides together, matching raw edges. Sew with a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Turn Right side out and place on inside side seam of stocking with raw edge at the bottom, pin and stitch in place, securing the loop to the stocking.
