## 3 Wishes Fabric ${ }^{\oplus}$ Happy Fall Collection

- 1 yd - Black Solid
- $3 / 4$ yd - Truck (18118-MLT-CTN-D)
- $3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ - Words (18119-BGE-CTN-D)
- $1 / 2$ yd - Patchwork (18116-MLT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$ - Wreath (18117-BGE-CTN-D)
- $1 / 2$ yd - Beige Solid
- $3 / 8$ yd - Flowers (18120-TAN-CTN-D)
- 3 yds - Flowers (18120-TAN-CTN-D) for Backing-Directional


## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 62 " x 62" ( $157.48 \mathrm{~cm} \times 157.48 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4 "(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. woof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.


Black Solid - ( 1 yd x woof / 91.44 cm x 106.68 cm)
Cut 12 - 7" x 7" ( $17.78 \mathrm{~cm} \times 17.78 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $12-6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2-1 $1 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2 "(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 36.83 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2 - $1 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 " ~}{} \times 12 ½ "(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 31.75 \mathrm{~cm})$


Trucks - 18118 -MLT-CTN-D ( $3 / 4 \mathrm{yd} \times$ wof $/ 68.58 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 6-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ whf ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) for Binding
Cut 4-61⁄2" x $61 / 2 "(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$


Words - 18119 -BGE-CTN-D ( $3 / 4$ yd x wof / $68.58 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $16-6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$


Patchwork - 18116-MLT-CTN-D ( $1 / 2$ yd x wof / 45.72 cm x 106.68 cm)
Fussy Cut $1-12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 22^{\prime \prime}(31.75 \mathrm{~cm} \times 31.75 \mathrm{~cm})$

Cut $12-6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$

Cut 2 - $21 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 36.83 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 22^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 36.83 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

## Note: Check orientation of directional designs.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a Beige Solid square ( 7 " $\times 7^{\prime \prime} / 17.78 \mathrm{~cm} \times 17.78 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram A. Place on top of a Black Solid square ( $7^{\prime \prime} \times 7$ " / $17.78 \mathrm{~cm} \times 17.78 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) with RST and sew $1 / 4$ " ( 6.35 mm ) away from the line on both sides. Cut on the drawn line; press. Two squares yield two Half-Square Triangle (HST) Units. Square up and trim slightly to make two Half-Square Triangle Units ( $6 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 "}{} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime} / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Make 24.

2. Place a Black Solid strip ( $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 121 / 2 " / 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 31.75 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of the Fussy Cut Patchwork square ( $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2$ " / $31.75 \mathrm{~cm} \times 31.75 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram B. Pin RST, sew and press. Place a Black Solid strip ( 1 1/2" x $141 / 2 \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime} / 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 36.83 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Patchwork square with Black Borders should measure $141 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ( $36.83 \mathrm{~cm} \times 36.83 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

Place a Flowers rectangle ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2$ / $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 36.83 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side. Pin RST, sew and press. Place a Flowers rectangle $\left(21 / 2 " \times 18 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} / 6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm}\right.$ ) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Center Block should measure $181 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ $(46.99 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm}$.

 as shown in Diagram C. Pin RST, sew and press to make Side Unit 1A ( $61 / 2$ " $\times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make Side Unit 1B.
Note: Check the orientation of the HST Units and print direction of the square.
4. Follow Step 3 and Diagram D using four Words and two Black Solid squares
( $61 / 2$ " x $6 ½ " / 16.51 \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make two Side Unit 2's ( $61 / 2$ " x 18 ½" / $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm})$.

6. Place Side Unit 1A, Side Unit 2, Side Unit $3 A\left(61 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 " / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm}\right.$ ), the Center Block ( $181 / 2$ " $\times 181 / 22^{\prime \prime} / 46.99 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99$ cm ), and Side Unit 3B, Side Unit 2, Side Unit 3 A ( $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2 " / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram F. Pin RST, sew and press to make Row $4\left(18 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 541 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 46.99 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}\right)$. Note: Check the orientation of the HST Units and print direction of the squares.

7. Place two Flowers, two Black Solid, two Wreath, one Words squares and two HST Units ( $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram G. Pin RST, sew and press to make Row 1 ( $61 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 " / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check the orientation of the HST Units and print direction of the squares.

8. Follow Step 7 and Diagram H using two Flowers, two Black Solid, two Wreath, one Words squares and two HST Units ( $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ / $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make Row 7 ( 6 ½" x $541 / 22^{\prime \prime} / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). 9. Follow Step 7 and Diagram I using three Black Solid, two Wreath, two Words squares and two HST Units ( $61 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2{ }^{12}$ $/ 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make Row $2(61 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 " / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Dia. I

10. Follow Step 7 and Diagram J using three Black Solid, two Wreath, two Words squares and two HST Units ( $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " / $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make Row 6 ( $61 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 " / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

11. Follow Step 7 and Diagram H using two Wreath, two Words, one Truck squares and four HST Units ( $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 2{ }^{1 \prime}$ $/ 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make Row 3 ( $61 / 2$ x $541 / 2 " / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

12. Follow Step 7 and Diagram L using two Wreath, two Words, one Truck squares and four HST Units ( $61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51$ $\mathrm{cm})$ to make Row $5\left(61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 541 / 22^{\prime \prime} / 16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}\right)$.

13. Place Rows 1-7 as shown in Diagram M, matching the centers, ends and seams. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Happy Fall Quilt Top ( $541 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 541 / 22^{\prime \prime} / 138.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).


## Finishing

14. Remove the selvages from the Flowers Backing fabric. Note: Fabric is directional. Cut two pieces $401 / 4 " \times 62$ " ( $102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 157.48 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one piece $22 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 4^{\prime \prime}(56.52 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) one piece $221 / 4 " \times 221 / 4 "$ ( $56.52 \mathrm{~cm} \times 56.52 \mathrm{~cm}$. Pin RST and sew the two smaller pieces on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram N. Press the seam open or to one side. The Backing should measure 62" x 62" ( $157.48 \mathrm{~cm} \times 157.48 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

15. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, wrong side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
16. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
17. Binding - Follow Diagram O to make the Truck Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \mathrm{x}$ wof strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 " $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
