Quilt Size: 64-1/2" x 82-1/2"

Fabric A 2/3 yard (1 panel)

Fabric F 5/8 yard

Fabric B 2-2/3 yards

Fabric G 1-1/8 yards (Incl. Binding)

Fabric C 3/8 yard (or Fat Quarter)

Fabric H 3/4 yard

Fabric D 1/2 yard

Fabric I 1/3 yard (or Fat Quarter)

Fabric E 3/4 yard

Fabric J 5-1/4 yards (44/45" Backing Only)
or 2-1/8 yards 108" option

BASIC Twin Quilt #8

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 87" and (2) 8-3/4" x 69" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Fussy cut (8) 4-5/8" squares with motifs centered

Fabric D - Cut (2) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (12) 6-7/8" squares

Fabric E - Cut (8) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 63-1/2", (2) 2" x 48-1/2", and (2) 2" x 43" borders
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 27-1/2" borders.

Fabric F - Cut (3) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (18) 5-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally to make 36 triangles 

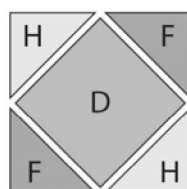
Fabric G - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (2) 1-5/8" strips, subcut (32) 1-5/8" squares
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 26" strips

Fabric H - Cut (4) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (22) 5-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally *only as shown* to make 44 triangles 

Fabric I - Cut (4) 1-5/8" strips, subcut (32) 1-5/8" x 4-5/8" strips

2. Piecing Order:

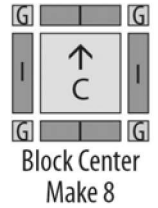
1. Sew 2 **Fabrics F** and **H** 5-3/8" triangles to sides of a **Fabric D** 6-7/8" square as shown. Make a total of 12 **Block 1** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 12

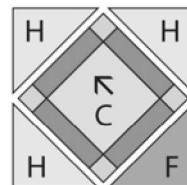
Stripes and arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Arrange 1 **Fabric C** 4-5/8" square and 4 each **Fabric G** 1-5/8" squares and **Fabric I** 1-5/8" x 4-5/8" strips in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 **Block Centers** (6-7/8" square unfinished).

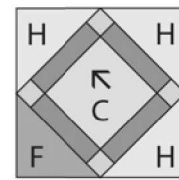

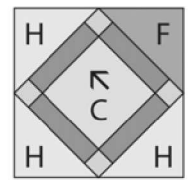
3. Sew **Fabric F** and **H** 5-3/8" triangles to each **Block Center** as shown to make 1 each **Blocks 2a-2h** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



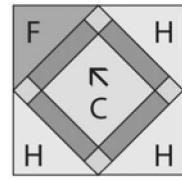
Block 2a - Make 1



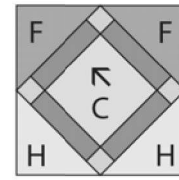
Block 2b - Make 1



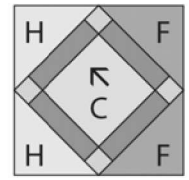

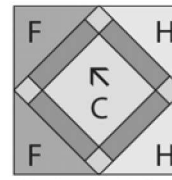

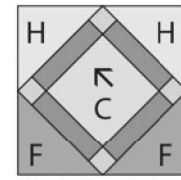

4. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks, panel, strips, and borders.

5. Stitch **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 26" **Fabric G** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 24-1/2" x 43" (unfinished).**

6. Sew **Fabric E** 2" x 43" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric E** 1-3/4" x 27-1/2" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.

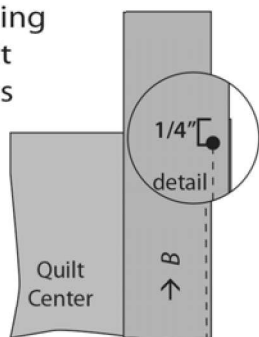

7. Arrange **Block 2f** and 4 **Block 1** in a vertical row on left side of quilt. Sew into a vertical border (9-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished) and stitch to left side of quilt. Arrange **Block 2g** and 4 **Block 1** in a vertical row on right side of quilt. Sew into a vertical border (9-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished) and sew to right side of quilt.

9. Arrange **Blocks 2a, 2b, and 2e** and 2 **Block 1** in a horizontal row above quilt. Sew into a horizontal border (9-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished) and stitch to left side of quilt. Arrange **Blocks 2c, 2d, and 2h** and 2 **Block 1** in a horizontal row on right side of quilt. Sew into a horizontal border (9-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished) and sew to right side of quilt. Quilt center measures 45-1/2" x 63-1/2" (unfinished)

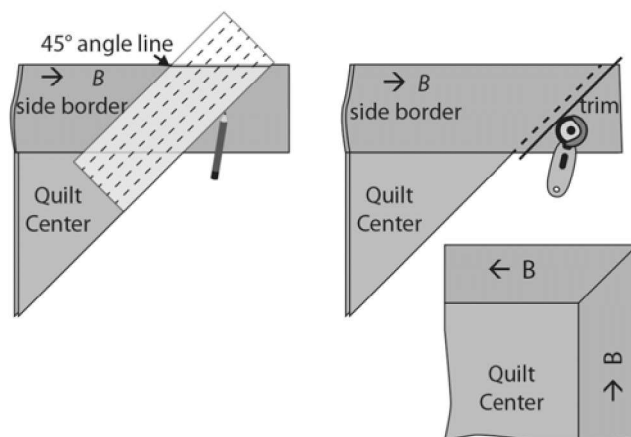
10. Sew **Fabric E** 2" x 63-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric E** 2" x 48-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

11. Center **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 87" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 69" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the floral stripe next to quilt center and the leaf border circling the quilt in a counter-clockwise direction. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

12. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



13. The quilt measures approximately 65" x 83" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

14. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

QUILT LAYOUT

Border measurements are the cut size.

Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.
