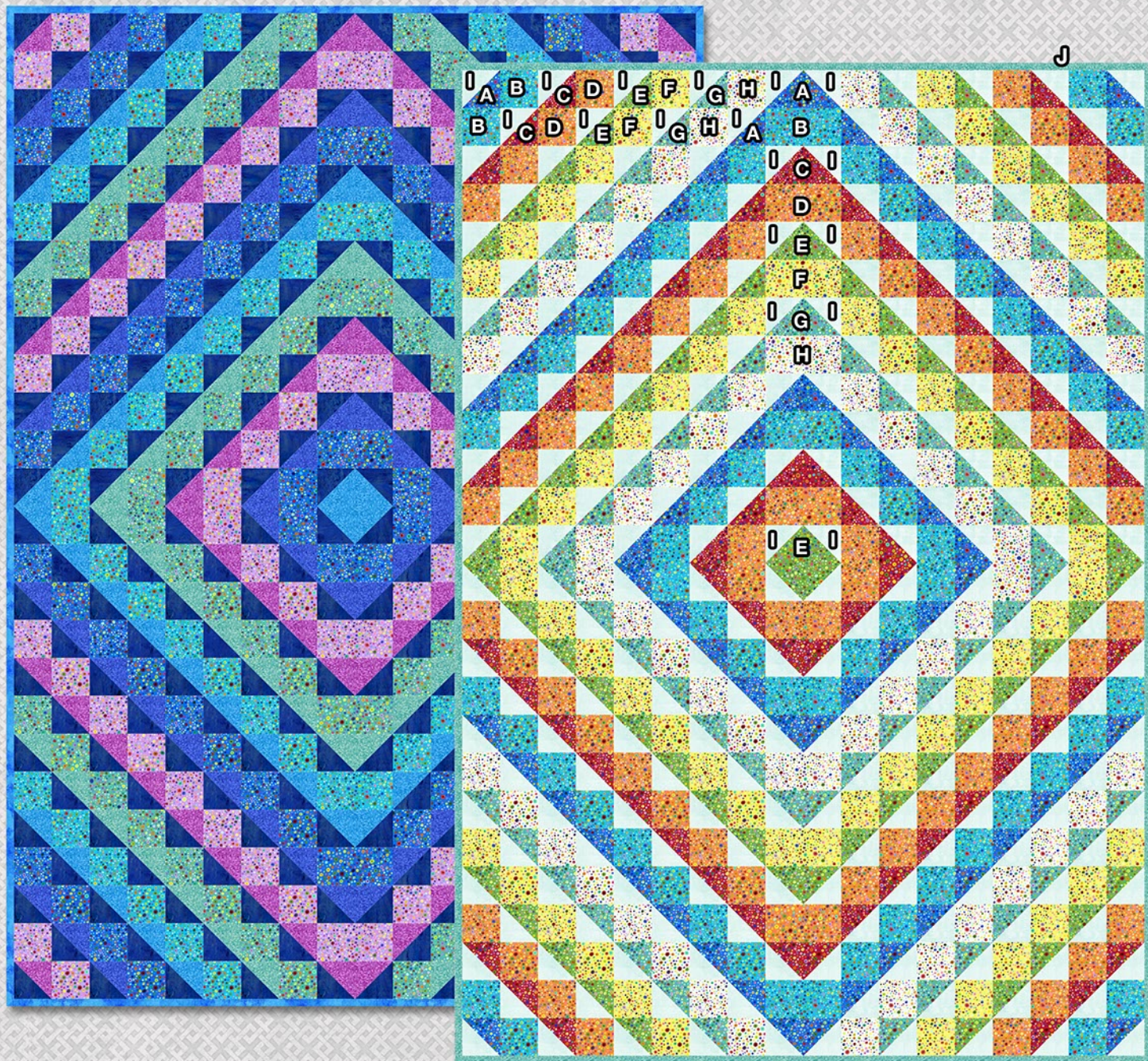

BASIC Medium Throw Quilt #11

Quilt Size: 45" x 65"

Fabric A 1/2 yard

Fabric B 5/8 yard

Fabric C 1/2 yard

Fabric D 5/8 yard

Fabric E 1/2 yard

Fabric F 1/2 yard

Fabric G 1/2 yard

Fabric H 1/2 yard

Fabric I 1-1/4 yards

Fabric J 5/8 yard (Binding Only)

Fabric K 3-1/8 yards (44/45" Backing Only)

BASIC Medium Throw Quilt #11

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabrics A, C, and E - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 6-1/4" squares then cut in half  diagonally twice for 8 triangles

Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (24) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 48 triangles

Fabrics B and D - From each fabric:

Cut (5) 3" strips, subcut (6) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces and (48) 3" squares

Fabrics F and H - From each fabric:

Cut (4) 3" strips, subcut (4) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces and (48) 3" squares

Fabric G - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 6-1/4" square then cut in half  diagonally twice for 4 triangles

Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (24) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 48 triangles 

Fabric I - Cut (10) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (118) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 236 triangles

Fabric J - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Not all cut Fabrics A, C, and E 6-1/4" triangles are used.

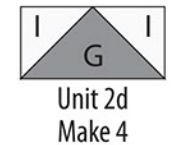
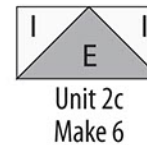
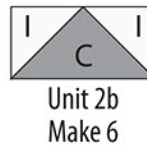
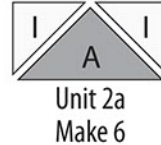
2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **Fabrics A** and **I** 3-3/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 24 Unit 1a (3" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 24 each Units 1b-1d with fabrics shown.

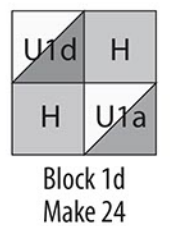
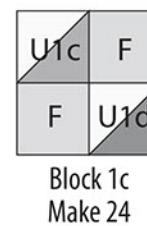
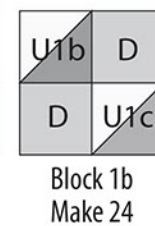
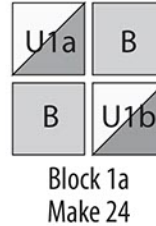

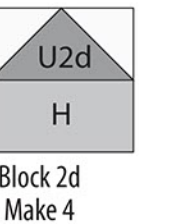
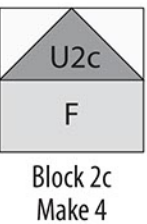
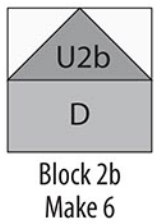
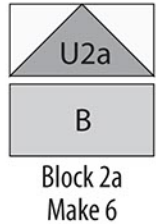
2. Sew 2 **Fabric I** 3-3/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric A** 6-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 6 Unit 2a (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 6 each Units 2b-2c and 4 Unit 2d.



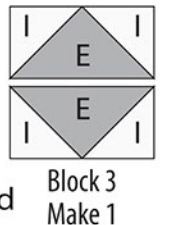
3. Arrange 2 **Fabric B** 3" squares and 1 each Units 1a and 1b in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 24 **Block 1a** (5-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 24 each **Blocks 1b-1d** with fabrics and units indicated.



4. Sew a **Fabric B** 3" x 5-1/2" piece to a Unit 2a as shown. Make a total of 2 **Block 2a** (5-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 each **Blocks 2b-2d**.



5. Sew 2 Unit 2c together as shown to make **Block 3** (5-1/2" square unfinished).



6. Refer to Quilt Layouts (Pages 2 and 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks for Versions 1 and 2.

7. Arrange blocks in 13 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.

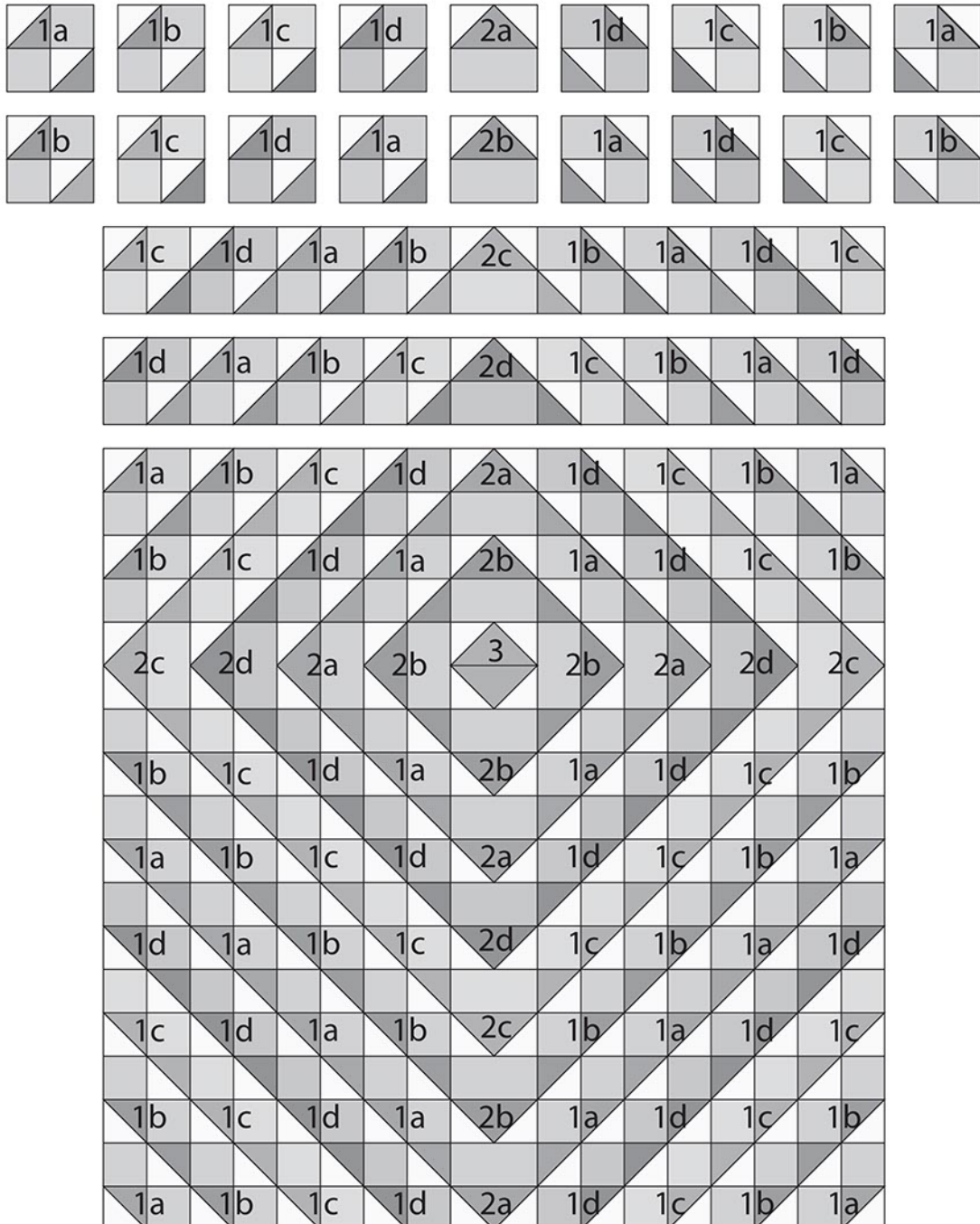
8. The quilt measures approximately 45-1/2" x 65-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!
