

CLASSIC Queen Quilt #1



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Fabric A 2-1/8 yards

Fabric B 2-1/3 yards

Fabric C 3/4 yard

Fabric D 3/4 yard

Fabric E 7/8 yard

Fabric F 2/3 yard

Fabric G 7/8 yard (Binding Only)

Fabric H 1-3/8 yards

Fabric I 7-7/8 yards (44/45" Backing Only)

2-2/3 yards (108" Backing Option)

Quilt Size: 84" Square

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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 6-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for a total of 4 triangles

Cut (11) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 72-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders

Fabric B - Cut (4) 9-3/8" strips, subcut (16) 9-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for a total of 32 triangles

Cut (5) 6-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (4) 6-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips

Fabrics C and D - From each fabric:

Cut (3) 7-1/4" strips, subcut (12) 7-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally for 48 triangles

Fabric E - Cut (2) 9-3/8" strips, subcut (8) 9-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for a total of 16 triangles

Cut (1) 6-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for a  total of 4 triangles

Fabric F - Cut (2) 9-3/8" strips, subcut (8) 9-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for a total of 16 triangles

Fabric G - Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric H - Cut (10) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (96) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for a total of 192 triangles

2. Piecing Order:

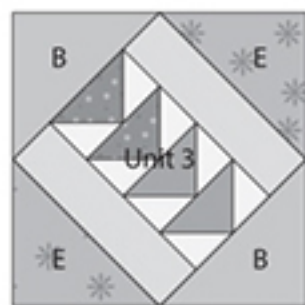
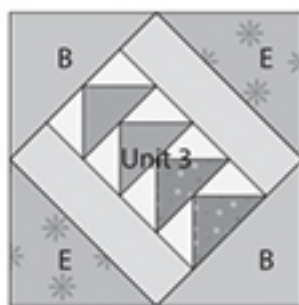
1. Sew 2 **Fabric H** 3-7/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric C** 7-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 48 Unit 1 (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 48 Unit 2 with a **Fabric D** 7-1/4" triangle.



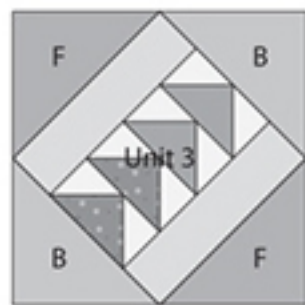
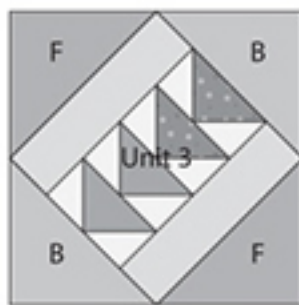
2. Arrange 2 each Units 1 and 2 in a vertical row as shown. Stitch together. Sew **Fabric A** 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips to sides. Make a total of 16 Unit 3 (12-1/2" square unfinished).



3. Stitch 2 each **Fabrics B** and **E** 9-3/8" triangles to sides of a Unit 3 as shown. Make a total of 4 each **Blocks 1a** and **1b** (17-1/2" square unfinished).



4. Stitch 2 each **Fabrics B** and **F** 9-3/8" triangles to sides of a Unit 3 as shown. Make a total of 4 each **Blocks 2a** and **2b** (17-1/2" square unfinished).



5. Stitch **Fabrics A** and **E** 6-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 4 Unit 4 (6-1/2" square unfinished).



Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

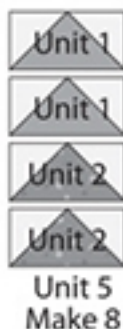
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6. Sew 2 each Units 1 and 2 in a vertical row. Make a total of 8 Unit 5 (6-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).

7. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks, borders, and units.

8. Arrange blocks in 4 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together into quilt center (68-1/2" square unfinished).

9. Sew **Fabric A** 2-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric A** 2-1/2" x 72-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.



10. Sew each **Fabric B** 6-1/2" x 48-1/2" strip between 2 Unit 5 to create borders (6-1/2" x 72-1/2" unfinished).

11. Sew borders to right and left sides of quilt.

12. Sew a Unit 4 to remaining 2 borders and stitch to top and bottom of quilt.

13. The quilt measures approximately 84-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

14. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!
