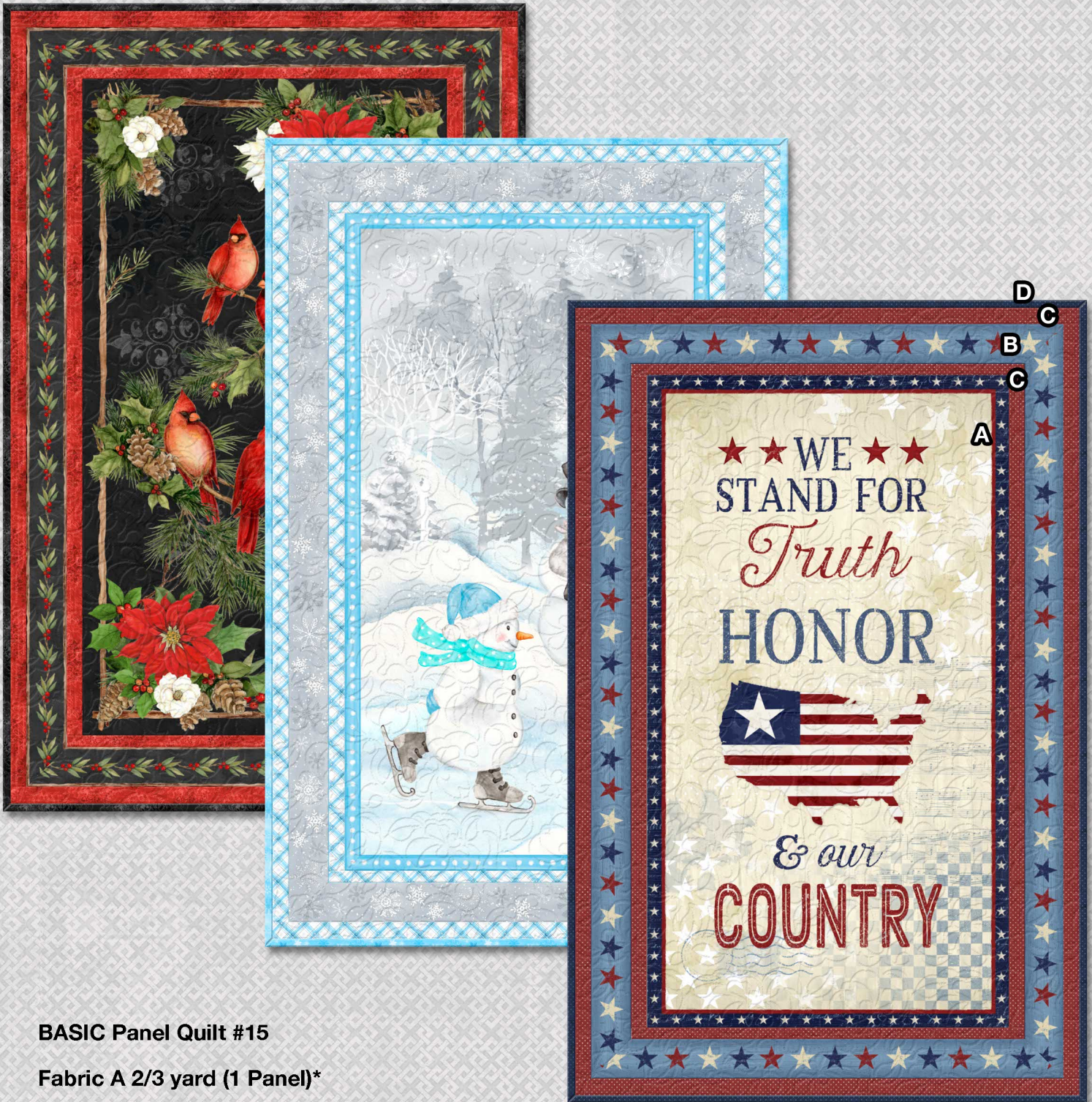


BASIC Panel Quilt #15



BASIC Panel Quilt #15

Fabric A 2/3 yard (1 Panel)*

Fabric B 1-7/8 yards*

Fabric C 2/3 yard

Fabric D 1/2 yard (Binding Only)

Fabric E 1-3/4 yards (44/45" Backing Only)

Quilt Size: 32" x 50"*

*Size may vary depending on width of Fabric 'B' stripes and finished size of Fabric 'A' Panel.

BASIC Panel Quilt #15

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 3" x 52" and (2) 3" x 34" borders

Fabrics C - Cut (2) 2" strips

Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 27" strips

Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, sew 2 strips together end to end and cut into (1) 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" and (1) 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" borders. Repeat with remaining strips for a total of 2 each length borders.

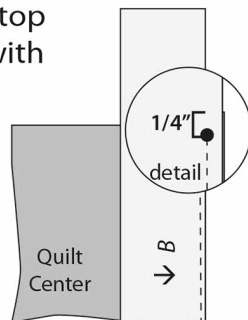
Fabric D - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

2. Piecing Order:

1. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.

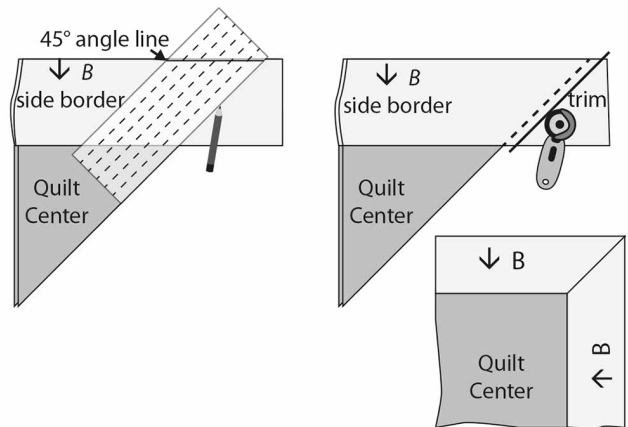
2. Stitch **Fabric C** 2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-3/4" x 27" **Fabric C** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 43-1/2" (unfinished)*

3. Center **Fabric B** 3" x 52" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 3" x 34" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the top edge next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

4. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



5. Sew **Fabric C** 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric C** 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

6. The quilt measures approximately 32-1/2" x 50-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric E**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

7. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!
