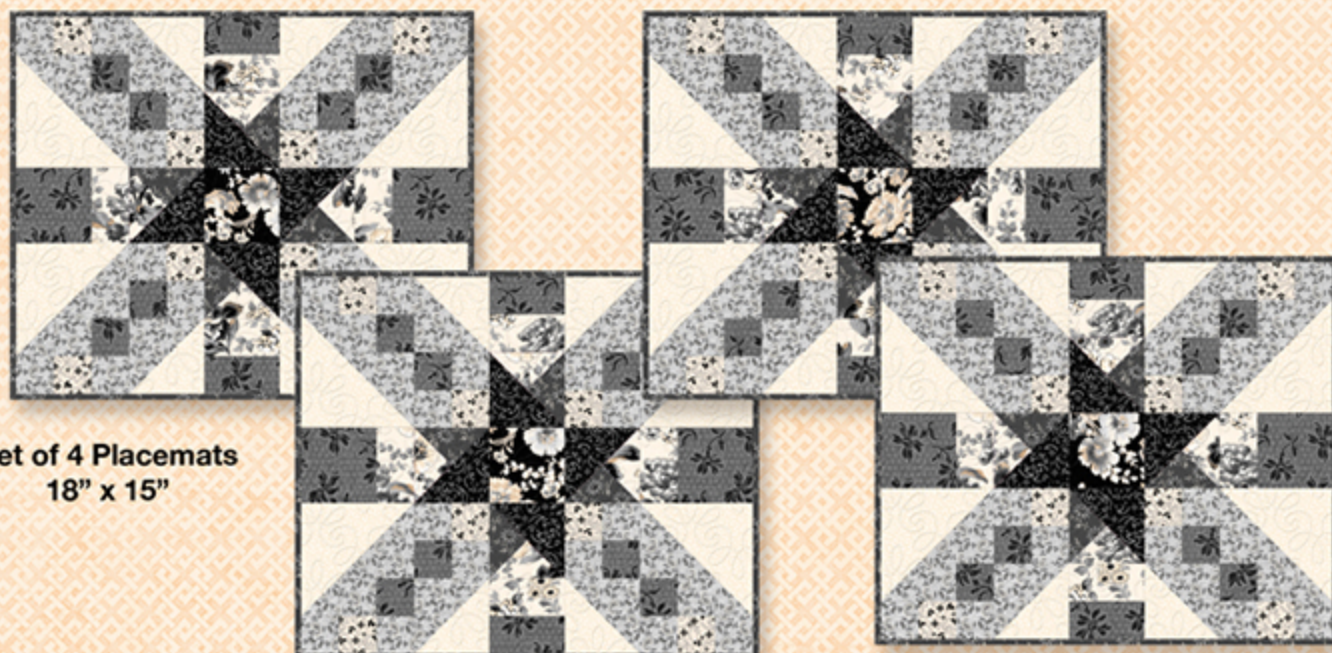

BASIC Placemats 9

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric B - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles

Fabric C - Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally  twice for 16 triangles
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric D - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally  twice for 16 triangles
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Fabric F - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (3) 2" strips, subcut (8) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces and (32) 2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (2) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (8) 5-3/8" and (8) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 16 each size triangles

Fabric H - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (16) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 32 triangles
Cut (1) 2-3/8" strip, subcut (8) 2-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles
Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (80) 2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (2) 18" strips, subcut (4) 18" x 21" backings

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 1 each **Fabrics C** and **E** 4-1/4" triangles together along their short edges as shown. Add a **Fabric B** 3-7/8" triangle along long edges. Make a total of 16 Unit 1 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



2. Stitch a **Fabric E** 2" x 3-1/2" piece to **E** edge of Unit 1. Add a **Fabric F** 2" x 3-1/2" piece as shown. Make a total of 8 Unit 2a (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 Unit 2b (3-1/2" x 8" unfinished) with a **Fabric F** 3-1/2" square in place of the **Fabric F** 2" x 3-1/2" piece.



3. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics F** and **H** 2" squares and 1 **Fabric H** 2-3/8" triangle in a row as shown. Stitch into row. Add a **Fabric H** 3-7/8" triangle as shown. Referring to diagrams for placement of squares and triangles, make a total of 8 each Units 3a and 3b (5-3/8" x 5-3/8" x 7-5/8" unfinished).



4. Sew a **Fabric G** 5-3/8" triangle to each Unit 3a and 3b along long edges. Make a total of 8 each Units 4a and 4b (5" square unfinished).



5. Sew a **Fabric D** 2" square between 2 **Fabric H** 2" squares as shown. Make a total of 16 Unit 5 (2" x 5" unfinished).



6. Arrange 2 **Fabric H** 2" squares and 1 each **Fabrics D** and **F** 2" squares in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 16 Unit 6 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



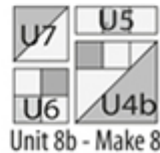

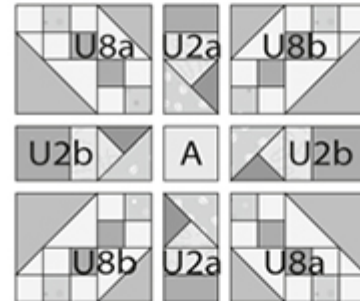
7. Sew 1 each **Fabrics G** and **H** 3-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 16 Unit 7 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



8. Arrange 1 each Units 4a, 5, 6, and 7 in 2 vertical rows as shown. Stitch into vertical rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Unit 8a (6-1/2" x 8" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 Unit 8b with units shown.



9. Arrange 1 **Fabric A** 3-1/2" square, and 2 each Units 2a, 2b, 8a, and 8b in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 placemat tops (15-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished).

10. For each placemat, layer and baste placemat top, batting, and backing (**Fabric I**) together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!
