- C 1/4 yard or FE
- D 1/8 yard or FE
- E 1/4 yard or FE
- F 1/8 yard or FE
- G 1/4 yard or FE
- H 1/4 yard or FE
- I 3/8 yard or FQ

Backing: Quilter's Choice 1-1/8 yards

FE = Fat Eighth FQ = Fat Quarter

Each set requires one 16" and one 18" pillow form.

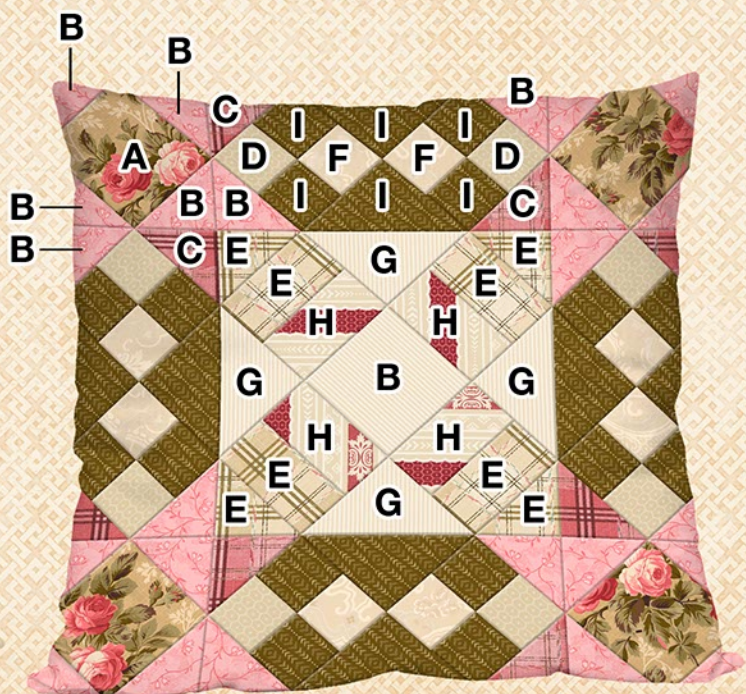

BASIC Patchwork Pillows

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Set 1 Pillows:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 3-1/2" square

Fabric B - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles], (5) 3-1/2" squares, and (4) 3" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles]

Fabric C - Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/4" square [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles] and (2) 3" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles]

Fabric D - Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (12) 2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, (1) 4-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles], (2) 3-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles], (8) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces, and (2) 3" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles]

Fabric F - Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (16) 2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles] and (4) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles]

Fabric H - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (2) 3-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles], (2) 3" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles], and (8) 2" squares

Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (8) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Fabric I - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles], (4) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles], and (2) 3-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles]

Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (24) 2" squares

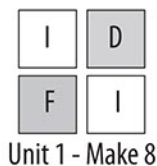
Backings - Cut (1) 17-1/2" strip, subcut

(2) 17-1/2" x 21" pieces

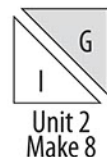
Cut (1) 15-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 15-1/2" x 21" pieces

2. Piecing Order for 15" Pillow:

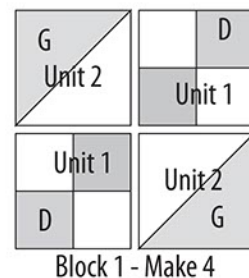
1. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics D** and **F** and 2 **Fabric I** 2" squares in 2 rows. Sew squares into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Unit 1 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



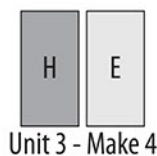
2. Sew 1 each **Fabrics I** and **G** 3-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 2 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



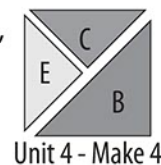
3. Arrange 2 each Units 1 and 2 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 1** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



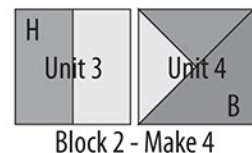
4. Sew 1 each **Fabrics E** and **H** 2" x 3-1/2" pieces together along their long edges. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



5. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics C** and **E** 4-1/4" triangles and a **Fabric B** 3-7/8" triangle as shown. Sew the smaller triangles together. Add the larger triangle. Make a total of 4 Unit 4 (3-1/2" square unfinished).

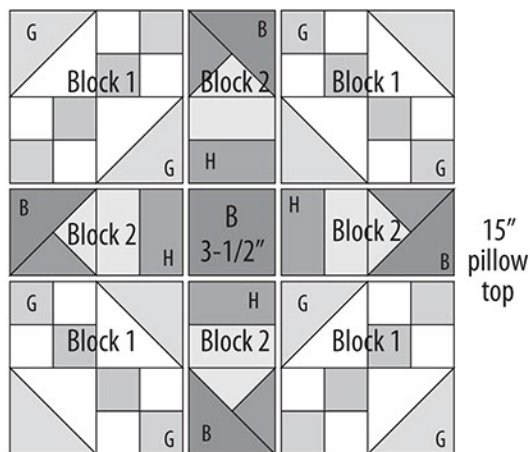


6. Stitch together Units 3 and 4. Make a total of 4 **Block 2** (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).

7. Arrange the blocks and a 3-1/2" **Fabric B** square in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete 15" pillow top (15-1/2" square unfinished)



8. Line pillow top with a piece of batting a little larger than the pillow top. Quilt as desired. Trim excess batting.

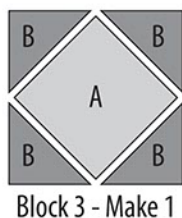
9. Fold each backing piece in half right side out so the 15-1/2" edges align. Press fold flat.

10. Place pillow top face up. Arrange backing pieces on top, with raw edges aligned, the folds overlapping in the center. Sew around edges with 1/4" seam. Stitch around a second time to secure. Sew raw edges with a zig zag stitch to reduce fraying.

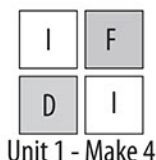
11. Turn right sides out. Stuff with a 16" pillow form and enjoy.

3. Piecing Order for 17" Pillow:

1. Sew **Fabric B** 3" triangles to all sides of a **Fabric A** 3-1/2" square as shown to make a **Block 3** (4-3/4" square unfinished).



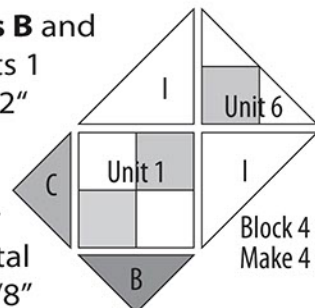
2. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics D** and **F** and 2 **Fabric I** 2" squares in 2 rows. Sew squares into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Unit 1 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



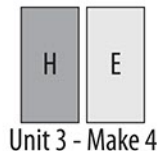
3. Arrange 2 **Fabric I** 3-3/8" triangles and a **Fabric F** 2" square in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Unit 6 (3-7/8" x 3-7/8" x 5-1/2" unfinished).



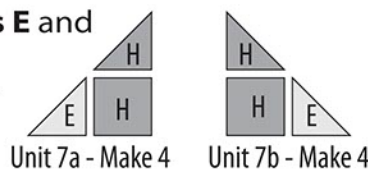
4. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics B** and **C** 3" triangles, 1 each Units 1 and 6, and 2 **Fabric I** 5-1/2" triangles in 3 rows as shown. Sew together into horizontal rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 4** (4-3/4" x 6-7/8" unfinished).



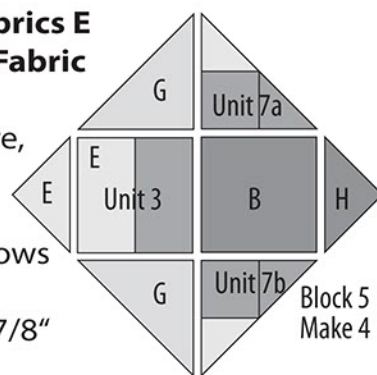
5. Sew 1 each **Fabrics E** and **H** 2" x 3-1/2" pieces together along their long edges. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



6. Sew 1 each **Fabrics E** and **H** 3-3/8" triangles to sides of a **Fabric H** 2" square as shown to make 4 each Units 7a and 7b (3-7/8" x 3-7/8" x 5-1/2" unfinished).

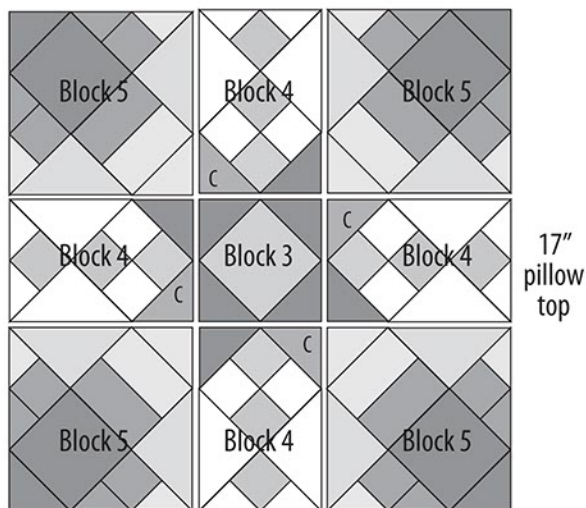


7. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics E** and **H** 3" triangles, 2 **Fabric G** 5-1/2" triangles, a **Fabric B** 3-1/2" square, and 1 each Units 3, 7a, and 7b in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 5** (6-7/8" square unfinished).

8. Arrange the blocks in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete 17" pillow top (17-1/2" square unfinished)



9. Refer to Steps 8-11 for 15" Pillow using 17-1/2" backing pieces and aligning them on their 17-1/2" edges. Stuff with an 18" pillow form and enjoy.

4. Cut the following for Set 2 Pillows:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (5) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric B - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles] and (1) 3-1/2" square
Cut (1) 3" strips, subcut (12) 3" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles]

Fabric C - Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles] and (4) 3" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles]

Fabrics D and F - From each fabric:
Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (16) 2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles], (8) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces, and (2) 3" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles]

Fabric G - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 5-1/2" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles] and (4) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles]

Fabric H - Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (8) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Fabric I - Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles] and (4) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles]
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" squares

Backings - Cut (1) 17-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 17-1/2" x 21" pieces
Cut (1) 15-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 15-1/2" x 21" pieces

5. Piecing Order for 15" Pillow:

1. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics D and F** and 2 **Fabric I** 2" squares in 2 rows. Sew squares into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Unit 1 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



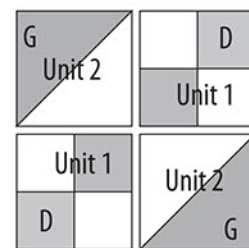
Unit 1 - Make 8

2. Sew 1 each **Fabrics I and G** 3-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 2 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



Unit 2

3. Arrange 2 each Units 1 and 2 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 1** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 4

4. Sew 1 each **Fabrics E and H** 2" x 3-1/2" pieces together along their long edges. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



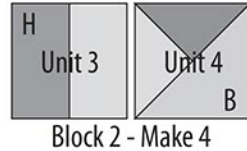

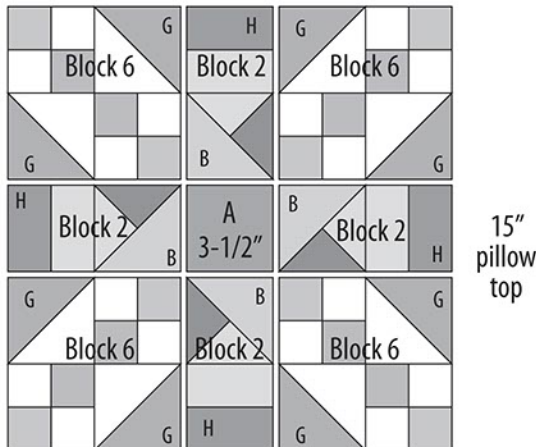
5. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics E** and **C** 4-1/4" triangles and a **Fabric B** 3-7/8" triangle as shown. Sew the smaller triangles together. Add the larger triangle. Make a total of 4 Unit 4 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



6. Stitch together Units 3 and 4. Make a total of 4 **Block 2** (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).



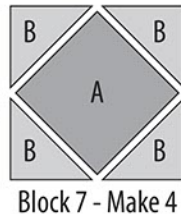
7. Arrange the blocks and a 3-1/2" **Fabric A** square in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete 15" pillow top (15-1/2" square unfinished).



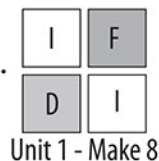
8. Refer to Steps 8-11 for 15" Pillow to finish pillow.

6. Piecing Order for 17" Pillow:

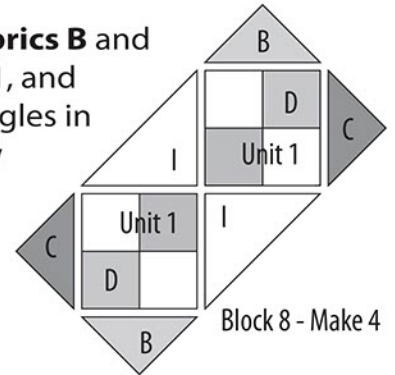
1. Sew **Fabric B** 3" triangles to all sides of a **Fabric A** 3-1/2" square as shown. Make a total of 4 **Block 7** (4-3/4" square unfinished).



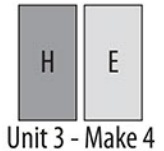
2. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics D** and **F** and 2 **Fabric I** 2" squares in 2 rows. Sew squares into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Unit 1 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



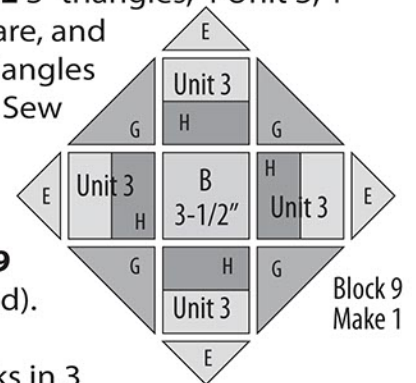
3. Arrange 2 each **Fabrics B** and **C** 3" triangles, 2 Unit 1, and 2 **Fabric I** 5-1/2" triangles in 4 rows as shown. Sew together into horizontal rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 8** (4-3/4" x 9" unfinished).



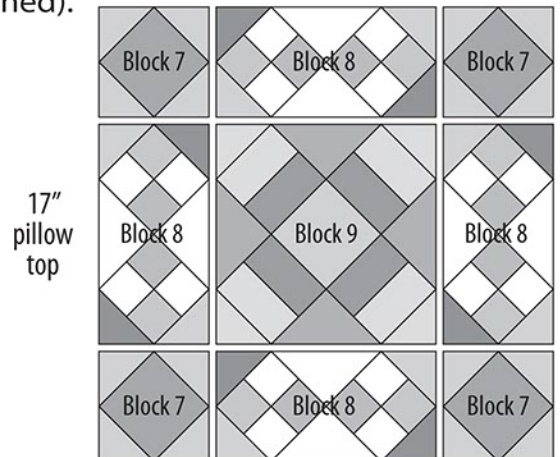
4. Sew 1 each **Fabrics E** and **H** 2" x 3-1/2" pieces together along their long edges. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



5. Arrange 4 **Fabric E** 3" triangles, 4 Unit 3, 1 **Fabric B** 3-1/2" square, and 4 **Fabric G** 5-1/2" triangles in 5 rows as shown. Sew together into horizontal rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 9** (9" square unfinished).



6. Arrange the blocks in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete 17" pillow top (17-1/2" square unfinished).



7. Refer to Steps 8-11 for 15" Pillow using 17-1/2" backing pieces and aligning them on their 17-1/2" edges. Stuff with an 18" pillow form and enjoy.
