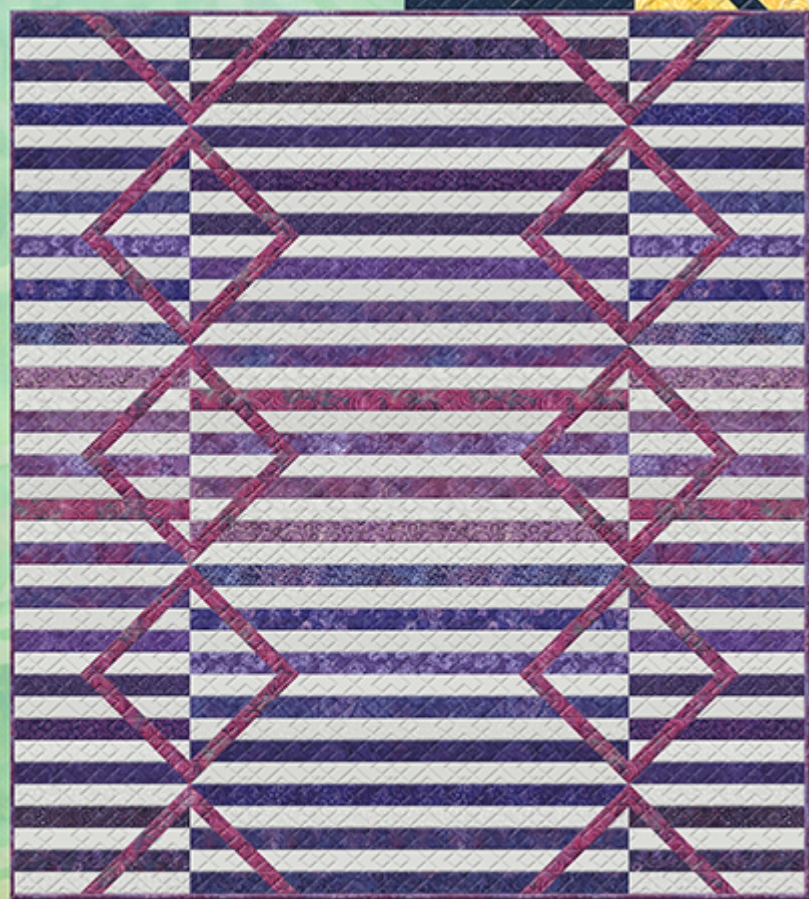

Throw Quilt:**
72" x 80"

Requires:

- A 1 - 40 Karat Pack
- B 1 - 40 Karat Pack
- C Diamond Strips
1 1/8 yds.
- D Binding - 2/3 yd.
- E Backing
44/45" - 5 yds.
or 108" - 2 1/3 yds.



- A 1 - 841-56-841 Island Hopping
- B 1 - 842-31-842 In the Navy

- A 1 - 841-58-841 Royal Treatment
- B 1 - 842-25-842 Silver Linings



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LINE DANCE

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvege to selvege, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric C - Cut (2) 16" strips, subcut (32) 2" x 16" strips

Fabric D - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

2. Piecing Order:

1. Arrange 1 each print from **Fabrics A** and **B** 2-1/2" strips strip packs in a vertical column, alternating **A** and **B** strips. Stitch the strips together in 8 sets of 5 (10-1/2" x width of fabric unfinished). Trim each to 41-1/4" long. Label as **Blocks 1a-1h**.

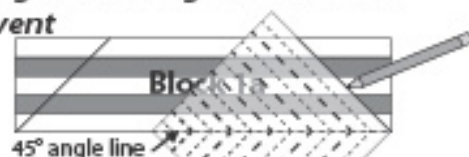
2. Arrange remaining strips from **Fabrics A** and **B** packs in a vertical column in the same order as Step 1. Stitch the strips together in 8 sets of 5 (10-1/2" x width of fabric unfinished). From each strip set cut (2) 10-1/2" x 16-7/8" pieces and label as **Blocks 2a-2h**.

Block Layouts

Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

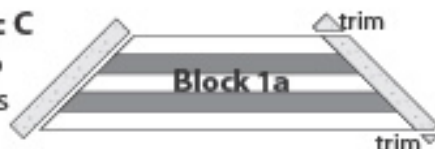
3. Mark a 45-degree diagonal line on each end of **Block 1a**, starting at the bottom corners. Cut along marked lines. *Use caution when handling and cutting these bias cut edges to prevent stretching.*



4. Sew a **Fabric C**

2" x 16" strip to diagonal edges of the center

section of **Block 1a** as shown. Trim **Fabric C** strips even with long edges of block.



5. Stitch triangles removed in Step 3 to ends of block so top edges and stripes are aligned.



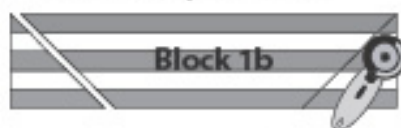
6. Trim Block 1, cutting from the bottom of the diagonal seams up, to approximately 40-1/2".

7. Repeat Steps 3-6 to make **Blocks 1c, 1e, and 1g**.

8. Complete **Blocks 1b, 1d, 1f, and 1h** in a similar manner. Start by drawing diagonal lines from the top corners, cut the bottom corners from the blocks, then add the **Fabric C** and removed corners. Trim to approximately 40-1/2".

NOTE: Diagonal **Fabric C** strips will be added to **Blocks 2a-2h** with the fabrics in the same order as they are in **Blocks 1a-1h**, as shown in **Block Layouts** (Page 1). When arranged in rows for quilt assembly they will be turned upside down.

9. Mark a 45-degree diagonal line on each

Block 2a, starting at

the bottom corners as shown, 1 in 1 direction and the other in the opposite direction. Cut along marked lines. *Use caution when handling and cutting these bias cut edges to prevent stretching.*



10. Referring to Steps 4-6 add **Fabric C** 2" x 16" strips to diagonal edges of the larger sections of **Block 2a**, trim **Fabric C** strips even with long edges of blocks, and stitch triangles removed in Step 9 to ends of blocks, aligned with top edge of block. Trim **Blocks 2a** and **reverse 2a**, cutting from the bottom of the diagonal seams up, to approximately 16-1/2" wide.



Make 1 each Block 2a and Reverse Block 2a

11. Repeat Steps 9-10 to complete **Blocks 2c, reverse 2c, 2e, reverse 2e, 2g, and reverse 2g.**

12. To complete **Blocks 2b, reverse 2b, 2d, reverse 2d, 2f, reverse 2f, 2h, and reverse 2h** in a similar manner. Start by drawing diagonal lines from the top corners, cut the bottom corners from the blocks as shown, then add the **Fabric C** strips and removed corners. Trim to approximately 16-1/2" wide.



Make 1 each Block 2b and Reverse Block 2b

Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

13. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks.

14. Arrange blocks in 8 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.

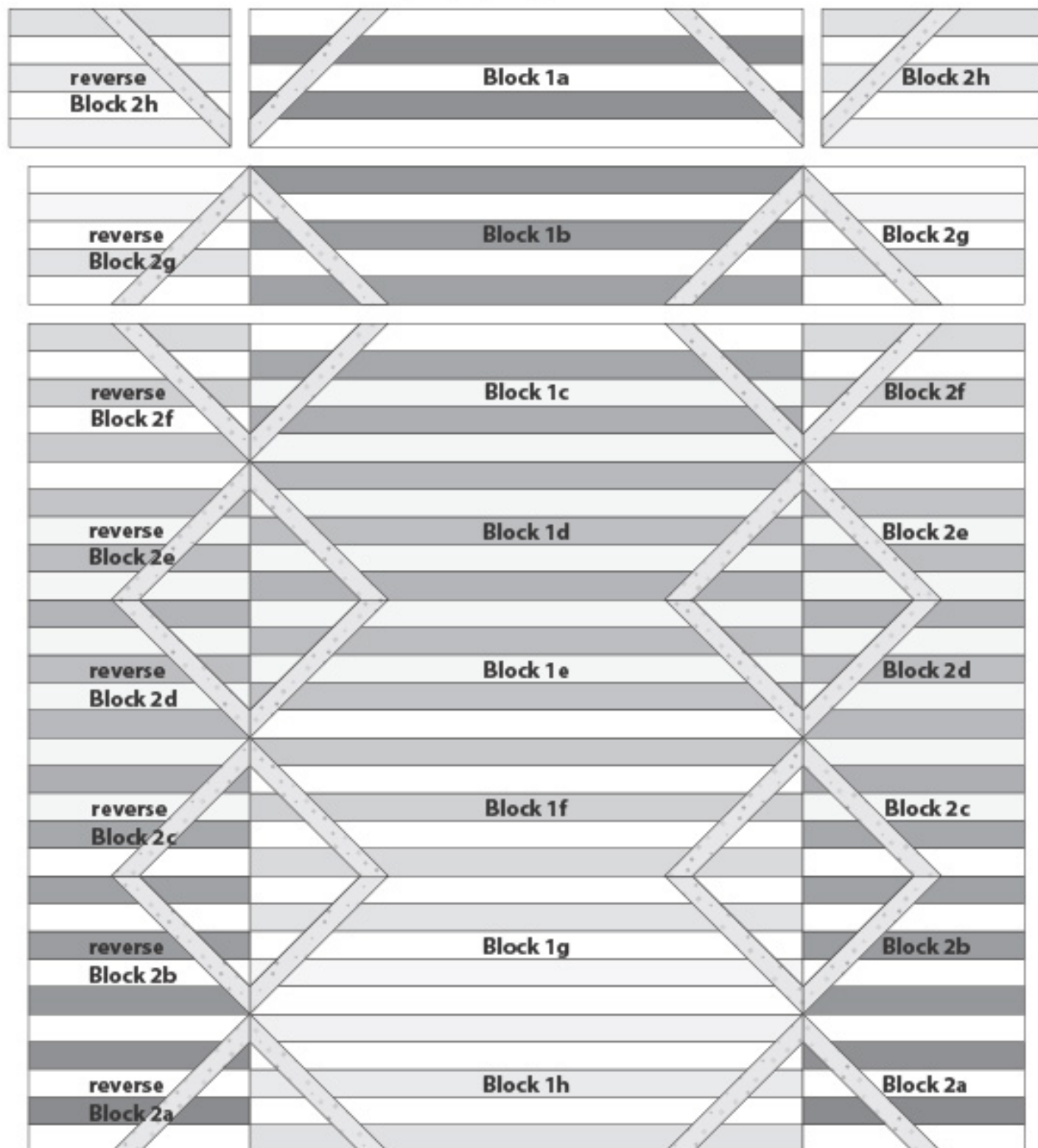
15. The quilt measures approximately 72-1/2" x 80-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric E**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!

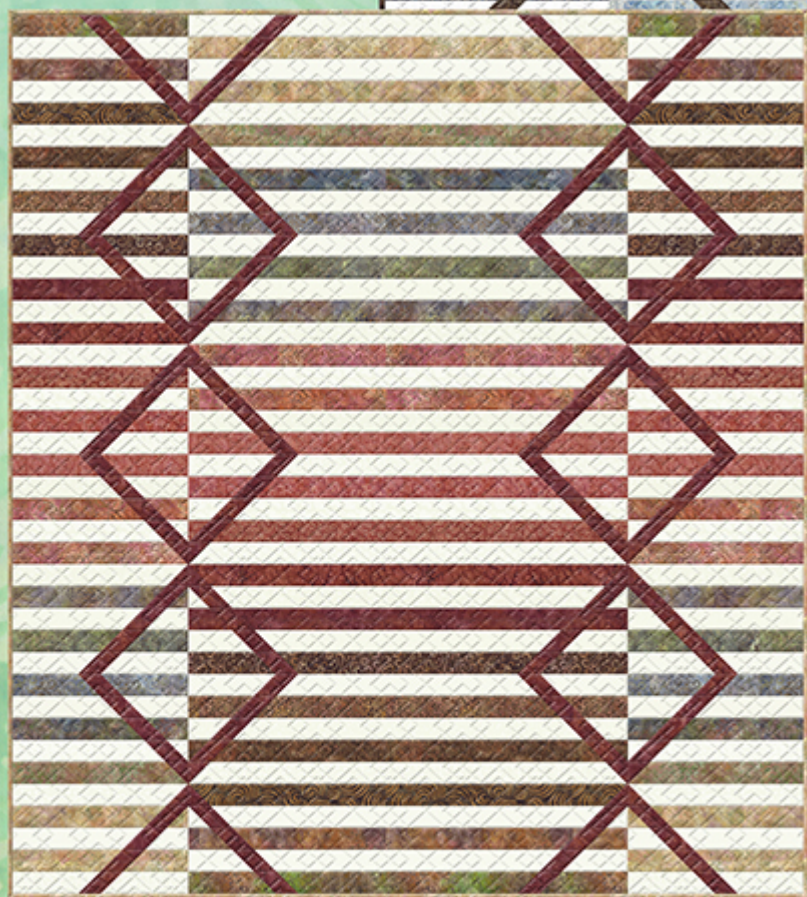
