



Conundrum (Version 1)

Featuring 40 Karat Gems or Crystals



Throw Quilt: 56" x 68"

Requires:

- A 1 - 40 Karat Pack (Including Binding)
- B 1 - 40 Karat Pack (Background)
- C Backing 44/45" - 3 2/3 yds.
or 108" - 2 yds.

1 - 840-765-840 - Fanciful Flight

1 - 842-86-842 - Dry Brush White



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Conundrum - Version 1

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric B - From (1) 2-1/2" strip, cut

(2) 2-1/2" x 10" strips

From (20) 2-1/2" strips, cut (320) 2-1/2" squares

From (12) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 64-1/2",

(2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2", (2) 2-1/2" x 56-1/2", and

(2) 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders

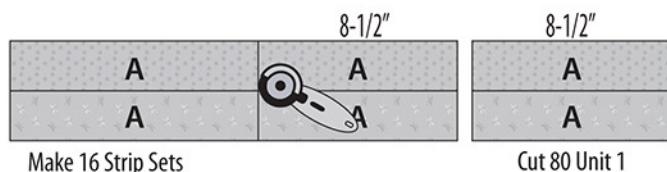
Note: Prints in strip pack may vary from color quilt image.

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 2 randomly selected **Fabric A**

2-1/2" x WOF (width of fabric) strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 16 strip sets.

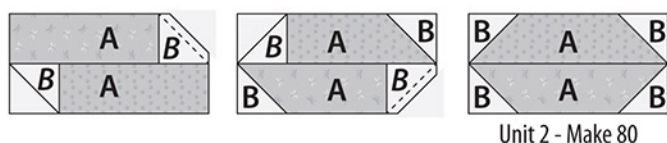
From these, cut (80) 8-1/2" wide Unit 1 (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished).



2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabric B** 2-1/2" squares. 

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

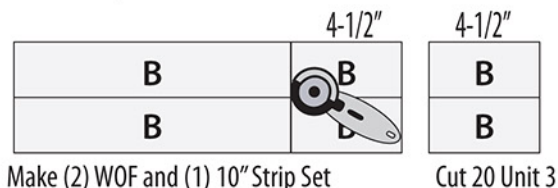
3. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric B** 2-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a Unit 1. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 80 Unit 2 (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished).



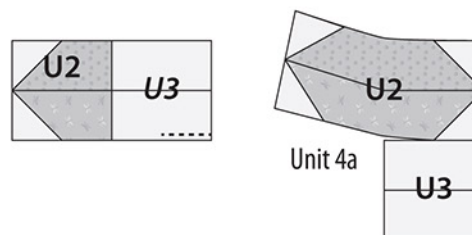

4. Sew 2 randomly selected **Fabric B**

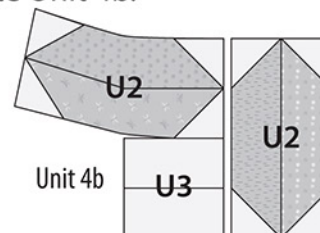
2-1/2" x WOF strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 2 WOF strip sets and 1 strip set made from (2) 2-1/2" x 10" strips. From these, cut (20) 4-1/2" wide Unit 3 (4-1/2" square unfinished).



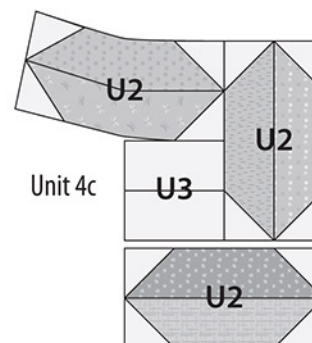
5. Arrange a Unit 3 right sides together on right end of a Unit 2 as shown. Stitch from right end to half way through the Unit 3. Press the partial seam to Unit 2 to create Unit 4a.



6. Sew a Unit 2 to the right side of Unit 4a. Press seam allowance to newly added Unit 2 to complete Unit 4b.

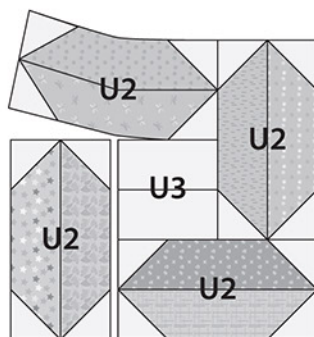


7. Sew a Unit 2 to the bottom of Unit 4b. Press seam allowance to newly added Unit 2 to complete Unit 4c.



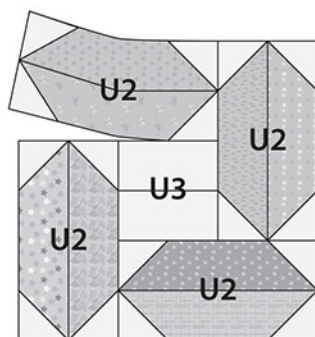
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8. Sew a Unit 2 to the left of Unit 4c. Press seam allowance to newly added Unit 2 to complete Unit 4d.

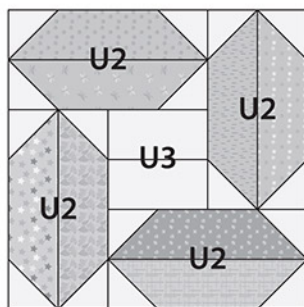


Unit 4d

9. Stitch the remainder of the partial seam joining the top Unit 2 to the Unit 3 and left Unit 2 to complete 1 block (12-1/2" square unfinished).



10. Repeat Steps 5-9 to make a total of 20 blocks.



Make 20 Blocks

Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

12. Arrange blocks in 5 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (48-1/2" x 60-1/2" unfinished).

13. Sew **Fabric B** 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric B** 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

14. Sew **Fabric B** 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric B** 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

15. The quilt measures approximately 56-1/2" x 68-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric C**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

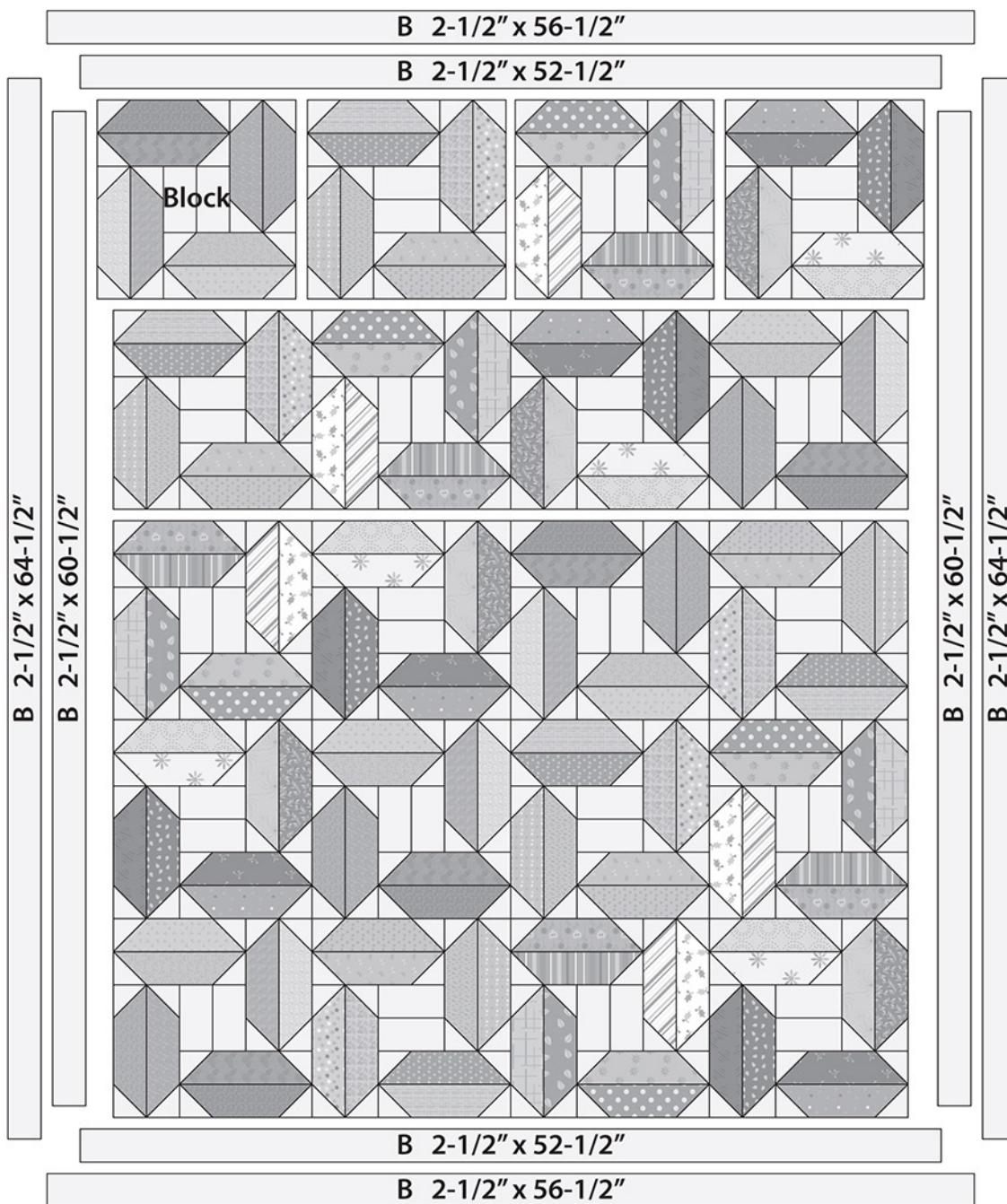
16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (seven 2-1/2" strips **Fabric A**) and enjoy!!

Conundrum - Version 2

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

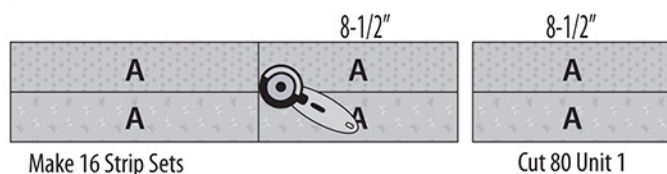
1. Cut the following:

Fabric B - Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, cut (18) 4-1/2" squares
 Cut (6) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders, (2) 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders, and (2) 4-1/2" squares
 Cut (20) 2-1/2" strips, cut (320) 2-1/2" squares

Note: Prints in strip pack may vary from color quilt image.

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 2 randomly selected **Fabric A** 2-1/2" x WOF (width of fabric) strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 16 strip sets. From these, cut (80) 8-1/2" wide Unit 1 (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished).

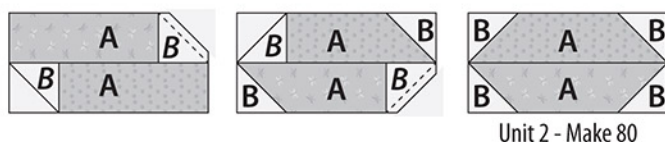


2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabric B** 2-1/2" squares.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

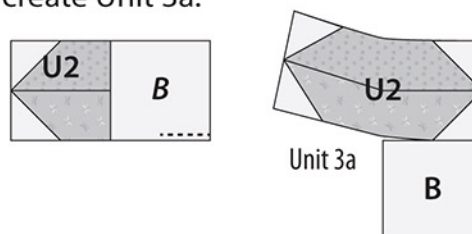
3. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric B** 2-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a Unit 1. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 80 Unit 2 (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished).



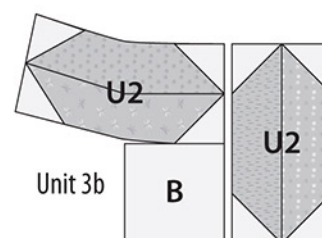
Unit 2 - Make 80

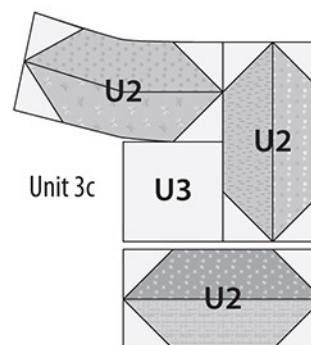
4. Arrange a **Fabric B** 4-1/2" square right sides together on right end of a Unit 2 as shown. Stitch from right end to half way through the **Fabric B** square. Press the partial seam to Unit 2 to create Unit 3a.



5. Sew a Unit 2 to the right side of Unit 3a. Press seam allowance to newly added Unit 2 to complete Unit 3b.

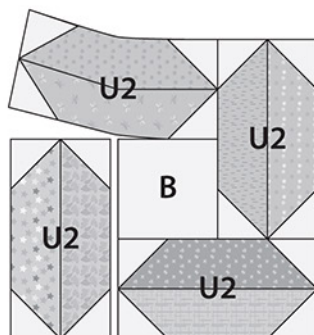


6. Sew a Unit 2 to the bottom of Unit 3b. Press seam allowance to newly added Unit 2 to complete Unit 3c.



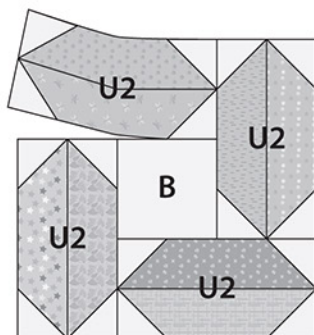
Conundrum - Version 2

7. Sew a Unit 2 to the left of Unit 3c. Press seam allowance to newly added Unit 2 to complete Unit 3d.

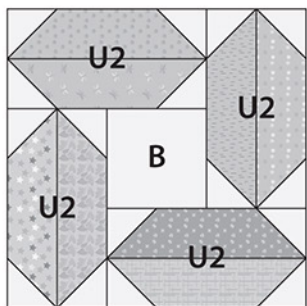


Unit 3d

8. Stitch the remainder of the partial seam joining the top Unit 2 to the **Fabric B** 4-1/2" square and left Unit 2 to complete 1 block (12-1/2" square unfinished).



9. Repeat Steps 4-8 to make a total of 20 blocks.



Make 20 Blocks

10. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

11. Arrange blocks in 5 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (48-1/2" x 60-1/2" unfinished).

12. Sew **Fabric B** 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric B** 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

13. The quilt measures approximately 56-1/2" x 68-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric C**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

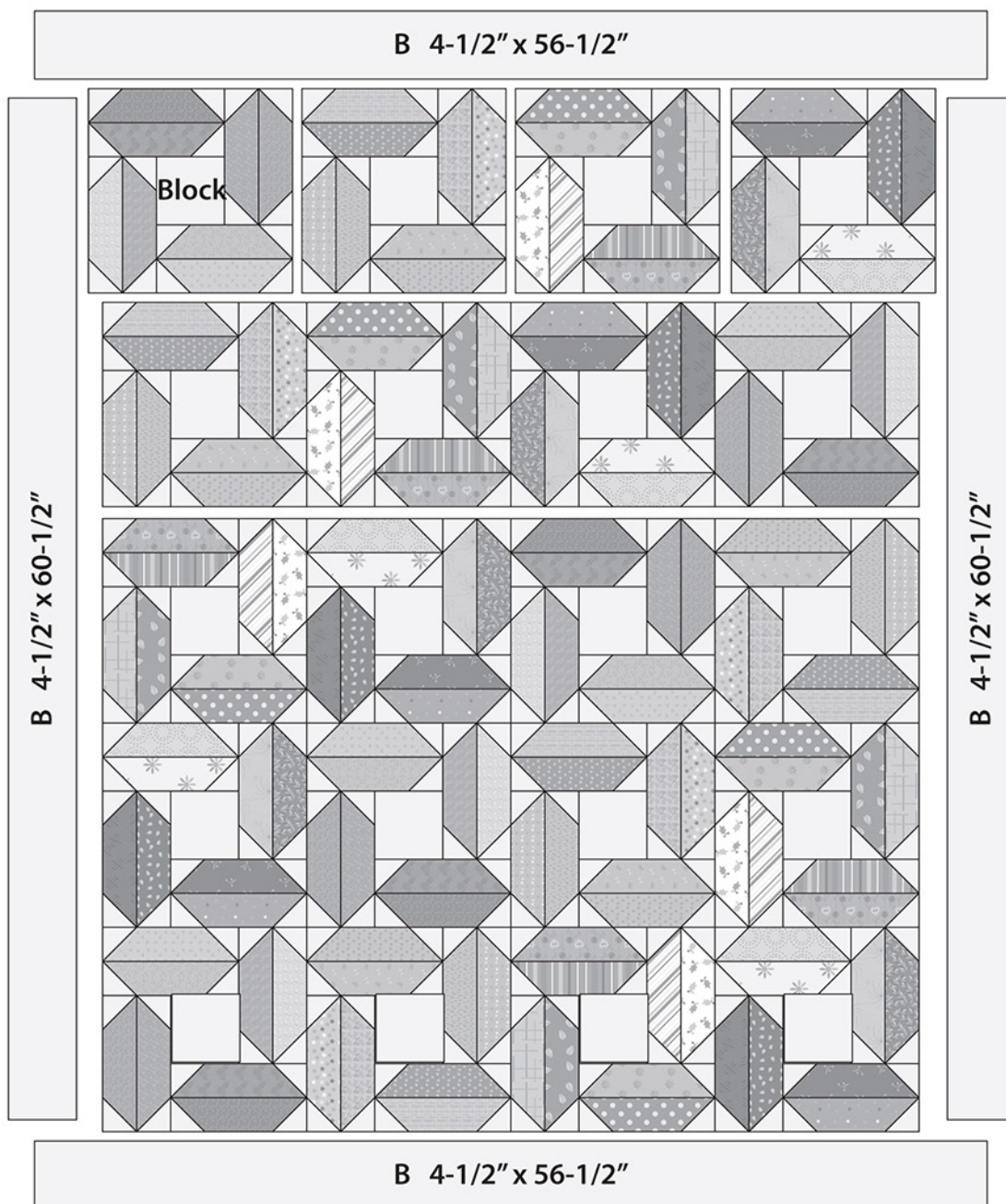
14. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (seven 2-1/2" strips **Fabric A**) and enjoy!!

Border measurements are the cut size.

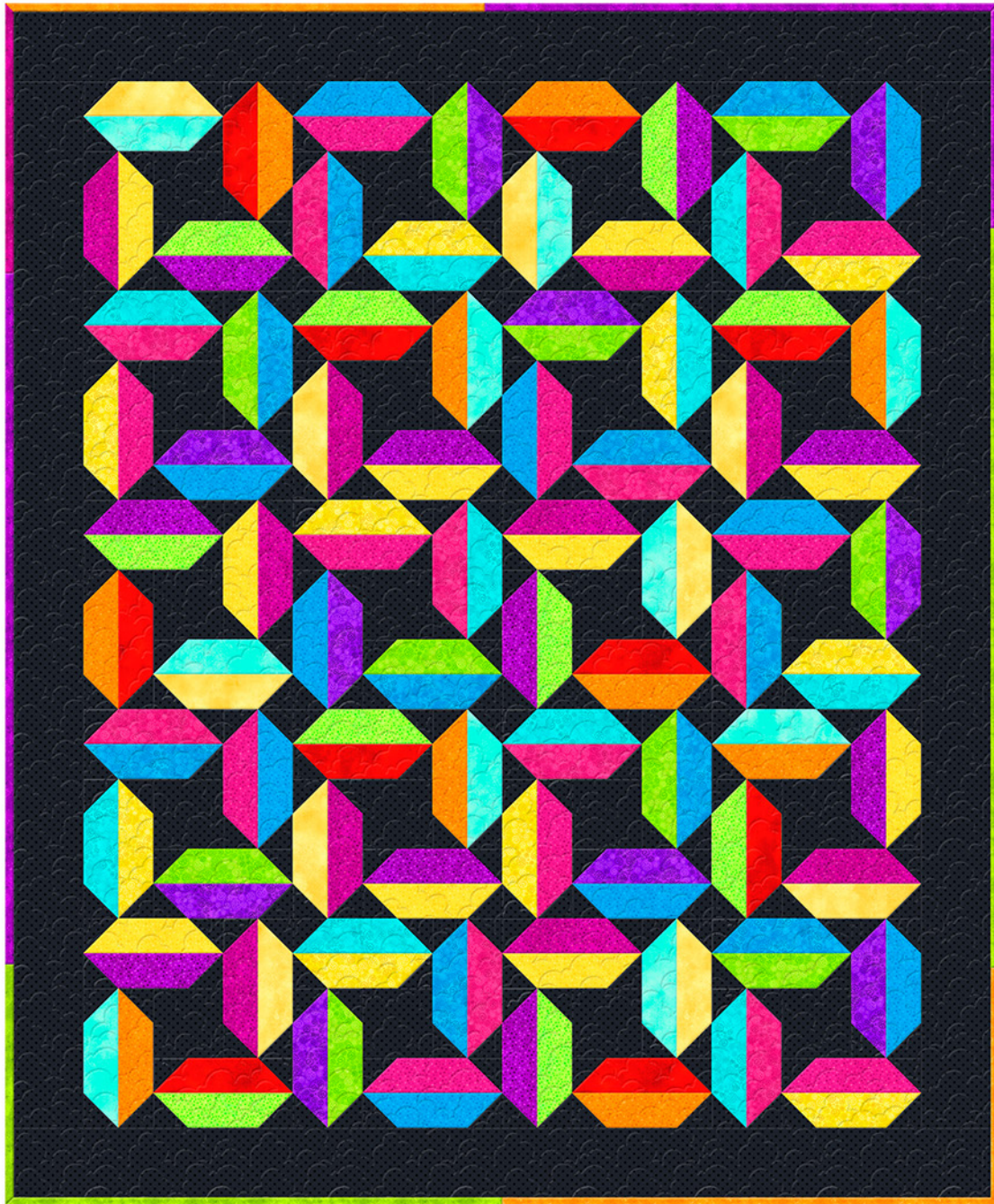
