



# BOHO PLACEMATS

## Standard Instructions:

1. Read all directions before starting.
2. This pattern is built off of  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.
3. WOF - stands for Width of Fabric.
4. RST - stands for Right Sides Together.
5. Directions include SIX - 20" Diameter Placemats.

## Materials:

Fat Quarters	- 6
Background Fabric	- $\frac{2}{3}$ Yard
Backing	- 2 Yards
Binding	- 6 Fat Quarters (One per each placemat) or 1 yard (For all)
Batting	- 24" square scrap battings

*Yardage is calculated from a 42" wide fabric. Binding is calculated for using 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide strips. This pattern also uses a paper template, so an erasable fabric marking tool will be needed.*


## Cutting:

1. With all fat quarters, trim them first to 18" x 20" rectangle subcut into:
  - 5 - 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20" strips
  - 1 - 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20" rectangle
2. With the background fabric, cut 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF subcut into:
  - 30 - 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20" strips

## Piecing:

1. Take one print 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20" rectangle, 5 background 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20" strips, and 5 secondary print 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20" strips. Lay them like so in the Diagram down below. (Diagram "A")



## Piecing Continue:


2. Take the 5 background 1 ½" x 20" strips, and 5 secondary print 1 ½" x 20" strips and sew them together with a ¼" seam allowance. (Diagram "B") Press your seams to the dark side.

3. Sew your finished Diagram B strip set on the bottom of your print 10 ½" x 20" rectangle. (Diagram "C") Press your seams to the dark side.

## Quilting:


1. Before we turn this into a circle template, first you'll need to quilt it. You can either cut your backing into 6 - 24" squares or keep it all together, either way will work. Then you'll place your backing fabric wrong side up, followed by your batting squares on top then your finished quilt top made on Diagram C. You can either use a spray basting spray to hold everything in place or pins. Now quilt it.

## Turning Into A Circle:

1. Print out Template Pages 1 and 2. Make sure you are printing at 100%, DO NOT SCALE to print. Once printed, use the 1" square to measure for accuracy. If the square measure's 1" then take some scissors and cut on the exterior bold line of the templates. Then using scotch tape, join the two pieces together by matching up the grey half squares together.


2. Take your quilted 20" placemat squares and measure 10" from the edge from the bottom joining larger rectangle. (Blue Line - Diagram "D") Using an erasable fabric marking tool, place a dot on the 10" mark. (Red Dot - Diagram "D")

3. Place your paper template (T) on the top right shown on Diagram "E" and using a erasable fabric marking tool, draw a line on the curve. (Yellow curve on Diagram "E") Flip your template (T) over to the top left side and once again draw a line on the curve. Repeat to the bottom section.



## Turning Into A Circle Continue:


4. Now that you've drawn your curve, take some fabric scissor and carefully cut your curve out. (Diagram "F")

5. Now that you have your circle placemat cut out, all you will need to do is add Bias binding and you're done! Just repeat all steps to all six placemats.


### Directions:


