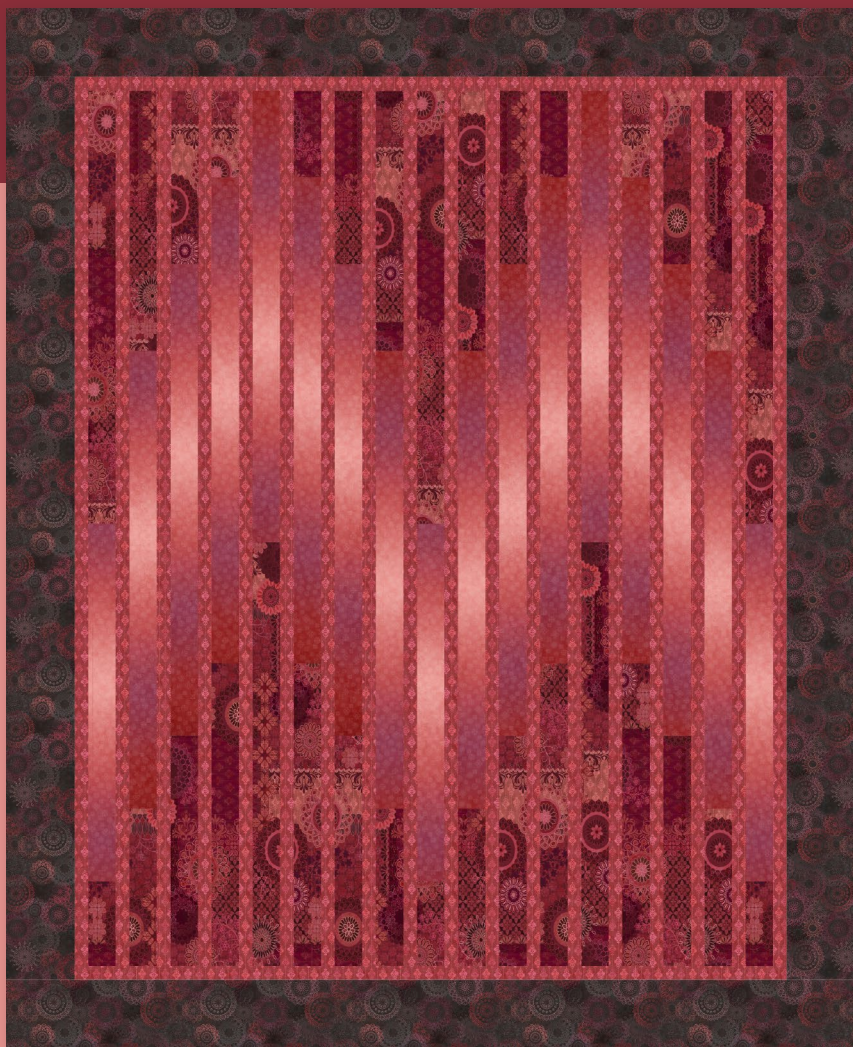

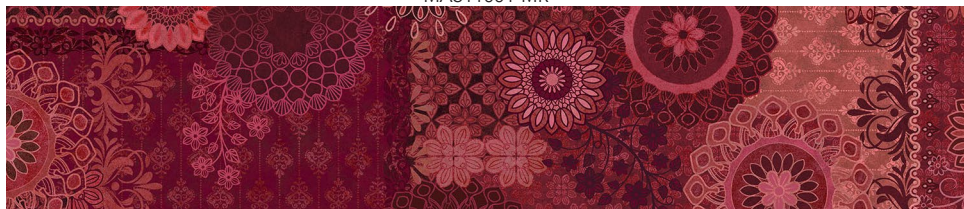

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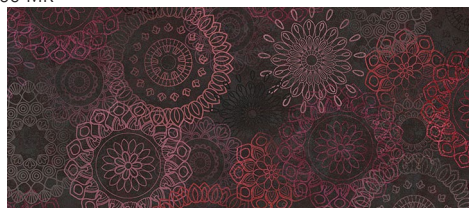

Fabric Requirements

Ombre	MAS11001-MR	1½ yards
Main	MAS11000-MR	1½ yards
Stripe	MAS11007-R	1¾ yards
Medallion	MAS11002-JM	2 yards
Backing		4 yards

Cutting

Finished size: 64 x 74

Ombre

*Refer to Diagram on P. 4

Center the lightest part of the print and cut
30½" x 54". From that piece, cut:
17 - 2½" x 30½" strips

Main

Cut:

17 - 2½" x WOF strips, into:
2 - 2½" x 30½" strips
7 - 2½" x 24½" strips
8 - 2½" x 18½" strips
8 - 2½" x 12½" strips
7 - 2½" x 6½" strips

Stripe

Cut:

3 - 1½" x WOF strips and piece together
to make
2 - 1½" x 52½" strips
From the Remaining Fabric Cut:
18 - 1½" x 60½" LOF strips

Medallion

Cut:

7 - 6½" x WOF strips for border
7 - 2½" x WOF strips for binding

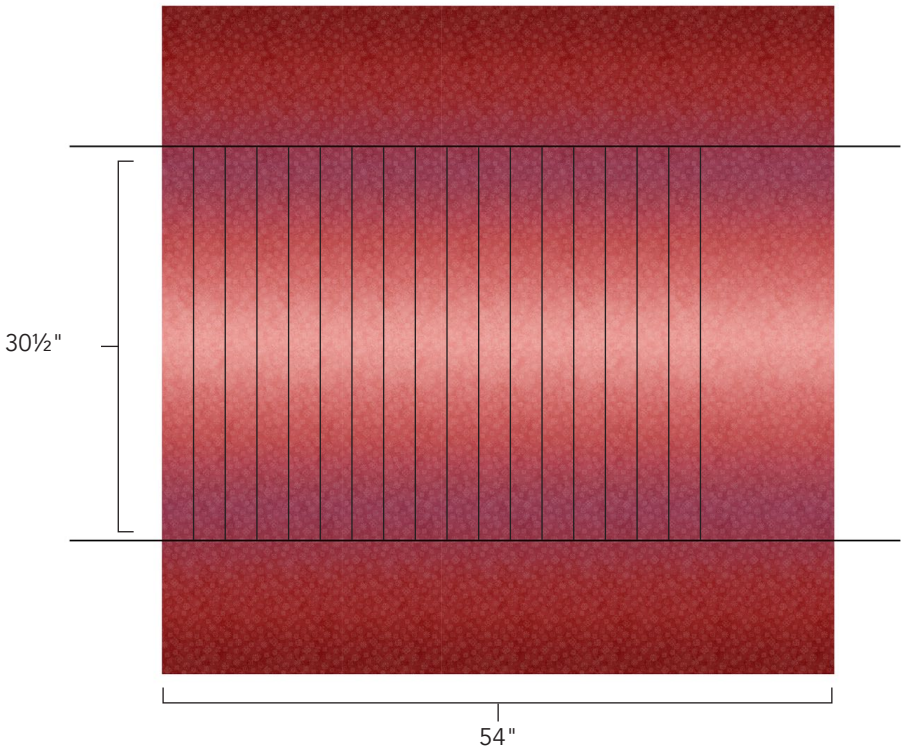
WOF - Width of Fabric

LOF - Length of Fabric

Skyline Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Ombre cutting diagram



A Units: Make 7

1. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of the main print to one end of a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of the ombre print and then sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of the main print. Press towards the main print. Repeat to make a total of seven A units.



B Units: Make 8

2. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of the main print to one end of a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of the ombre print and then sew to one end a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of main print to the other end of the ombre print. Press towards the main print. Repeat to make a total of eight B units.

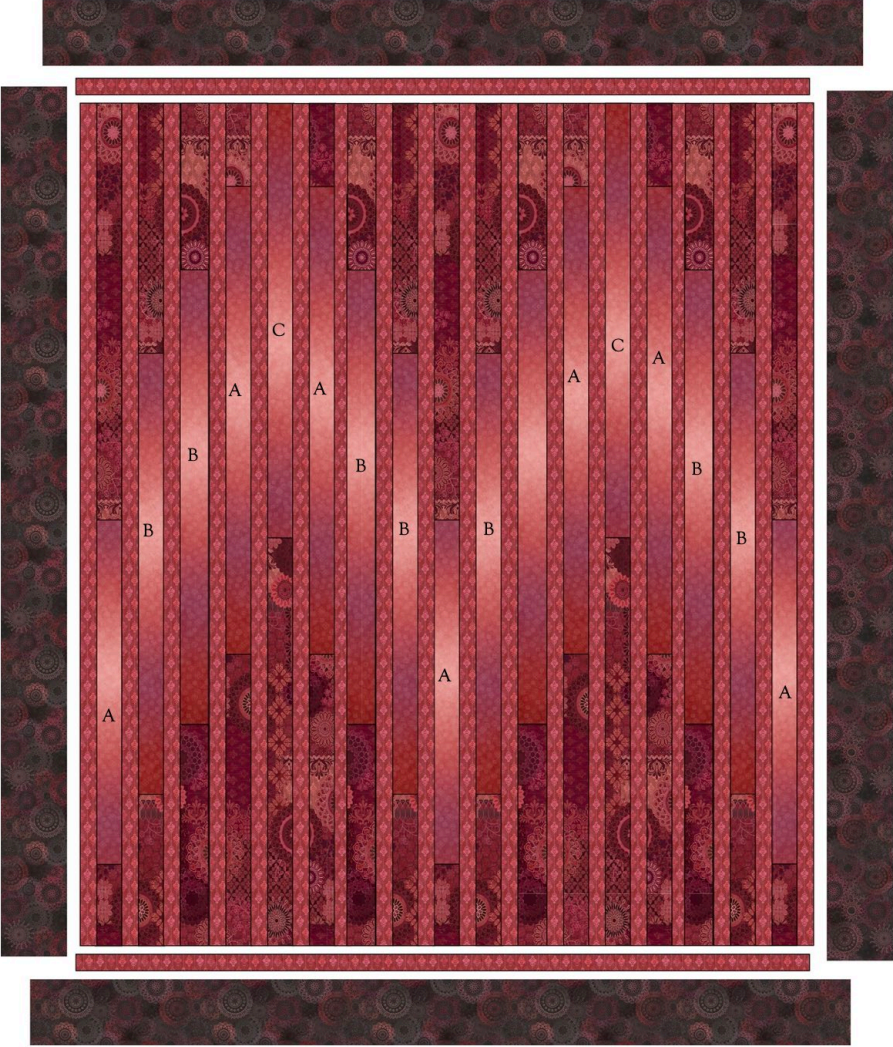


C Units: Make 2

3. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of the main print to one end of a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of the ombre print. Press towards the main print. Repeat to make a total of two C units.



4. Alternating the A units, B units, C units, and the 1½" x 60½" LOF strips of the stripe print, assemble the quilt top. Press towards the stripe print. Add the 1½" x 52½" strips of the stripe print to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press towards the stripe print. The quilt top should measure 52½" x 62½".



5. Piece together the 6½" x WOF border strips. Cut two border strips to 6½" x 62½" and add to the sides of the quilt top. Press out. Cut two border strips to 6½" x 64½" and add to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press out.

6. Quilt, bind, and enjoy!



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
