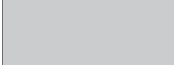

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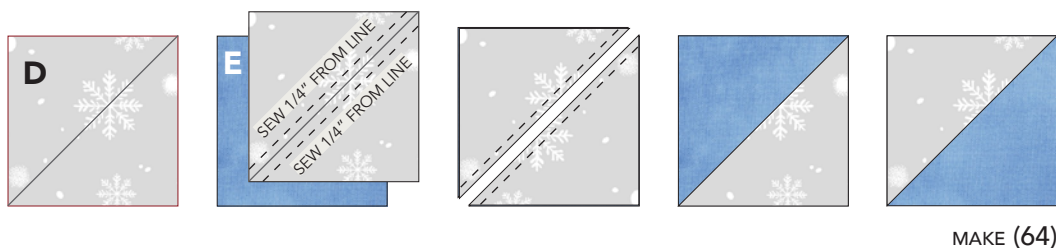
QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

REFER TO QUILT DIAGRAM ON PAGE 3 FOR ASSEMBLY.

1. Inner Border 1: Sew (1) **C** 2" x 41-1/2" strip to the long sides of **B** Panel 35-1/2" x 41-1/2" rectangle, followed by (1) **C** 2" x 38-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt panel.
2. Inner Border 2: Sew (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strip to sides of **B/C** quilt panel, followed by (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 42-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt center. Set aside.

PIECED BORDER ASSEMBLY

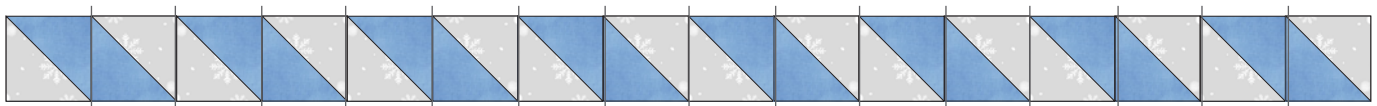
3. Half-Square Triangle (HST): Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **D** 4" square. Place **D** square, right sides together, on (1) **E** 4" square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Units should measure 3-1/2" square unfinished. Make (64).



4. Pieced HST Borders: Sew together (16) **D/E** HST units to make (1) pieced border. Make (4).

NOTE PROPER ROTATION AND PLACEMENT OF HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLES.

5. Inner Border 3: Sew Pieced Borders to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by the top and bottom.



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6. Inner Border 4: Sew (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" strip to long sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt center.
7. Outer Border: Sew (1) **C** 3" x 58-1/2" strip to long sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **C** 3" x 57-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt center.

QUILT DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **E** 2-1/4" strips.
