Rules of the Trail

- Signal turns and stops.
- Move to a single file to the right when oncoming trail users approach.
- Get off the trail or stay clear when stopped.
- Show respect for adjacent private property.
- Do not hunt or carry a firearm on or within 50 feet of the trail.
- No motorized vehicles or horses.
- Trail users are encouraged to wear appropriate safety equipment, including helmets.
- Announce "on your left" or "passing" before going around trail users from behind.
- · Leash and clean up after
- Keep the trail clean.
- Slow down when the trail is busy.
- Stay alert.
