This trade show is the U.S.-based sister event of the German h+h Cologne, the world's leading trade fair for the handicraft industry. The decision to bring this show to the US was based on an overwhelming demand among buyers and sellers in the handmade business.

Due to strong interest among buying groups, the 2023 event has broadened its product categories to include craft, hobby, and artists' supplies. Buyers will have access to materials and tools for a variety of handicrafts. Fabric is the big addition this year.

Sydney and I will attend classes and lectures, network, and explore new product offerings we can introduce to the store.

## **Moda Grunge Update**

If you have checked our website or stopped in the store you may have noticed our Moda Grunge collection with a number of holes. We received a letter from Mark Dunn, President of Moda Fabrics this week as he addressed the supply chain issues.

He reiterated that Moda Fabrics is dedicated to independent retailers and that they are proud to sell exclusively to specialty stores and not chains or "big box" retailers. He explained that Grunge Basics is their number one basic fabric collection. He apologized for their slow delivery and current out-of-stock conditions and noted that they are shipping at a 60% fill rate currently.

He went on to provide a little more context with the Grunge manufacturing process. Grunge is a slow manufacturing design because it is first dyed and then overprinted. This makes a product that has a two-fold possibility. The process of printing takes about six months. They have shipments coming in every four weeks but feel they will be having sporadic delivery for the next few months.

They wanted us to understand that they are doing everything to get back to "At Once Delivery".

We wanted to be transparent with you so you understand what is going on with Moda Grunge. We have a ton of fabric on order just waiting for it to be available in the warehouse and to ship.

Island Vacation was inspired by the magical atmosphere on the tropical volcanic island of Espiritu Santos, Vanuatu, South Pacific Ocean. Denise experienced tranquil days snorkeling over coral reefs in clear turquoise waters and warm, sunshine-filled days strolling barefoot along fine white sands under swaying palms. The locals, Ni Van people, live in thatched grass houses.

The women wear brightly colored block-printed sarongs and large hibiscus flowers in their hair. Tropical rainstorms create drenching, moist afternoons. A trip to the daily markets is a feast of color, excitement, bustle, and noise. Elongated papaya, mangos, and bananas are on display on woven mats. The Ni Van children sit on mats weaving "still green" banana and palm leaf baskets to bundle up red sweet potatoes. This fabric reflects this fresh, lively island scene.


# Row by Row 2023

Row by Row has started and runs from June 1 - August 31, 2023. We created two designs that are available for purchase in-store and online.


- **Sew I Wine** celebrates Loudoun County. On our drive to the store, we pass cows and numerous vineyards, so this plate depicts those views.


## **MEL's Practical Joy**
