

Check out some of her current patterns. For those of you who grew up when I did, you will recognize the cassette tapes in this quilt.


Radical Cassettes

The Radical Cassettes quilt pattern comes in a Large Throw size of 62" X 73". The Radical Cassettes quilt is considered an intermediate pattern due to the few drunkard's path blocks.

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Chaos Coordinator

The Chaos Coordinator quilt pattern comes in 4 sizes: Pillow/Wall Hanging (18"X18"), Baby (33"X33"), Small Throw (62"X62) and Large Throw (71"X71"). The Chaos Coordinator quilt is an intermediate/advanced pattern using curved piecing, such as the orange peel block.

The pattern includes a coloring page, detailed visuals to clearly illustrate the quilt construction and skills, and the bonus of 2+ Hrs of VIDEO TUTORIALS, including detailed tutorials for each block.


