

Women's History Month

As March comes to a close so does Women's History Month, to celebrate we want to highlight Susanne Miller Jones' HERstory Quilts: A Celebration of Strong Women. This is a long-overdue tribute to a selection of women who have shaped history through *herstory*, this rich collection of 108 mixed-media fiber art pieces celebrates extraordinary women who cracked glass ceilings, made important discoveries, or shook the world by breaking into fields dominated by men. The subjects of these exquisite quilts, by 85 artists from 7 countries, include politicians and scientists, environmentalists and entertainers, activists and artists, athletes and authors—and even a fictional heroine. The quilting medium mirrors the advances these women have made, as the art quilt movement has inspired women to express their creativity in a whole new way.

Susanne recently taught our Spicy Spiral Table runner class. Look for her to teach more classes. We have signed copies of her books available for sale.

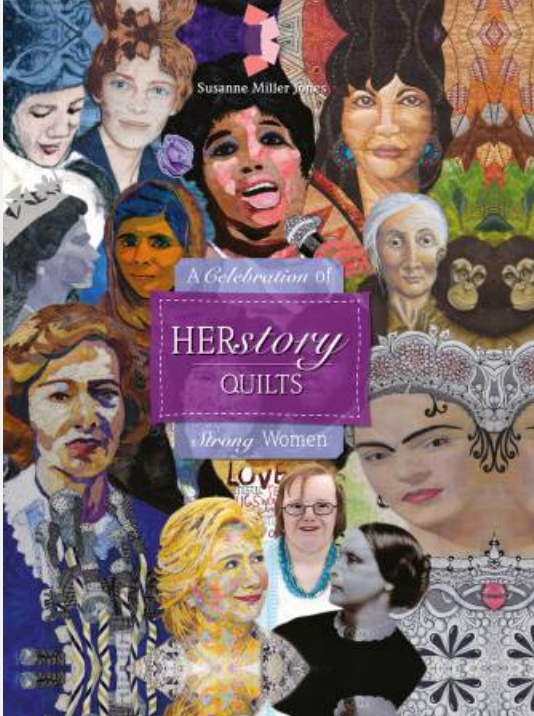

Spotted Graffiti is all about color and texture. It boasts a vibrant color palette of vivid magenta, ocean blue, golden yellow, speckled grey and the sandy beige of a wind battered beach. The organic texture and the super soft, high-density cotton make it a dream to stitch.

Wild Blossoms by Robin Pickens for Moda Fabrics

Robin's work projects range from greeting cards and calendars to collections for tabletop and entertaining, to rugs and home decor. Imagine a rainbow of colors, vibrant, free, and bursting with life in her Wild Blossoms collection. Wildflowers are the brave and bold blooms that proudly show their spirit and beauty. They are not afraid to grow in the most unexpected places.

Wild Blossoms, show the rainbow of colors in a big width-of-fabric print. This ombre panel (12" continuous repeat) blends from color to color along a rainbow, with busy bees visiting along the way. The WOF allows you to use it in one big stretch as a rainbow, or cut it up to have fun with all the flowers as you choose.

Coordinates for the group separate out some of the flowers. Bluebonnets, daisies, poppies, and Queen Anne's lace bring softness with pretty butterflies adding a pop of accent color. Leafy prints bring a mix of colors and monochromatic palette with different type of leaves. Little flower drawings, prints with canning jar vases and diagonal line print of blotted graph paper close out the line.

This is a large collection and you are sure to find just the right flowers for you quilt garden.

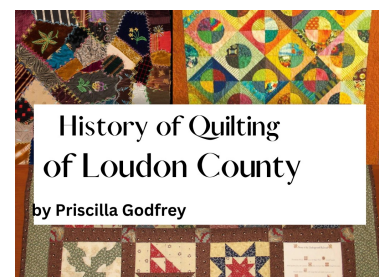

Hoffman 100-Year Challenge

CELEBRATE HOFFMAN FABRICS' 100 YEAR ANNIVERSARY WITH A SPECIAL EDITION OF THE HOFFMAN CHALLENGE

Hoffman California Fabrics was founded in 1924 by Rube P. Hoffman. Today, the fourth generation of the family carries on its traditions of design excellence, superior quality and forward-thinking textile fashion.

To celebrate, Hoffman California Fabrics has created a special edition of the Hoffman Challenge. For the first time ever, Hoffman Challenge participants are required to use a minimum of 5 out of 15 batik fabrics from the Challenge collection in their artwork entry. As a challenge participant, put your creative and technical skills to the test.

Participant registration, submissions and initial jurying all take place online, with a panel of certified judges considering all entries. If it is determined that your artwork qualifies for in person judging, you will be asked to mail it to Hoffman Fabrics.

Finalists' and award winners' artwork go on tour for the year of 2024 to celebrate Hoffman's 100th Anniversary. They will be displayed in their virtual showroom and exhibitors may include quilt shows and festivals, museums and libraries, cultural centers, guilds and even some Hoffman retailers.
