Desert Oasis from Create Joy Project for Moda Fabrics

Desert Oasis is a fabric line that is dear to Laura's heart. Her happiest memories growing up were in a majestic place, Lake Powell. This is a place to celebrate the beauty of nature. She has found more peace among the sparkling water and warm sunshine of Lake Powell than anywhere else on this earth. It is where she goes to become grounded with the earth, to be

washed in its beauty.

Desert Oasis's designs are inspired by this home away from home. Each piece of art was carefully crafted to emote the joy of escape, adventure, warmth, and peace that can be found in the travels to a beloved location awash in sunshine and cool water, red rock mountains, and magical cliffs.

In Desert Oasis, I created five gorgeous new flow fabrics; each color matched a beautiful element found in the landscape of Lake Powell. They are so rich and full of natural beauty. These are the grounding fabrics for the line. This collection is packed full of fabrics celebrating the red rock mountains and cliffs, warm sands, soft textural plants, unique rocks and pebbles, the culture of the area, the crisp blue sky, and the healing sunshine. Of course, no Create Joy Project fabric line is complete without some flowers, so she painted a loose, wild floral using all the colors and texture she found in the Lake Powell landscape.

Rust and Bloom by Sarah Sczepanski for FreeSpirit Fabrics

Sarah's second collection for FreeSpirit, Rust & Bloom, is inspired by the beauty of nature. Rust & Bloom features patterns found in nature, along with a



nod to the evolution of living things. Her inspiration can be drawn from the smallest details of nature, such as a beehive pattern, a rolling tide, or the natural patterns of ice on a window pane. Color also plays a large role in her inspiration. The colors she chose for Rust & Bloom show the beauty of a full day in nature, from the ochre skies of a morning sunrise to the deep blues of a winter night. You can see colors being pulled from all seasons of the year in Rust & Bloom.

The twelve designs in this collection are made from her original monotypes. Monotypes are a one-of-a-kind printmaking practice that she uses to create her artwork. Monotypes are created by painting directly onto a plate and running the plate through a printing press. Monotypes cannot be reproduced and, therefore, differ from other printmaking processes, like intaglio, that are etched into a plate. In her monotypes, she utilizes the unique and unexpected textures of natural and manmade objects such as vegetable wrappers, bubble wrap, leaves, or dried flowers. She enjoys this printmaking process because it involves a sense of spontaneity, and it always includes an element of surprise. This collection is meant to be like taking a long walk through nature.
