

# Mystery Block

## Totally Tulips

from MSQC

Need: per block

White on white: 1 – 10" x 10" square  
4 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares

Bright floral: 4 – 5" squares (put these in the basket provided by the design wall and pull out 4 different for your block)

Bright floral green: 1 – 10" x 10" square

Provided: 1 light green 1 ½" x 8 ½" strip

**PART 1 - the stem:** Take the 10" x 10" white and green, put right sides together. Mark the back of the white diagonally both ways corner to corner. Sew on both sides of the lines a ¼ of an inch (diagram 1). Cut horizontal and vertical down the middle and then diagonally between the stitched lines to make 8 HST (Half Square Triangles) (diagram 2). Be sure to square the HST's to 4 ½" squared. You will need 4 of the HST per block. You are provided with the light green fabric for the stem. Sandwich it between the HST's as in diagram 3.

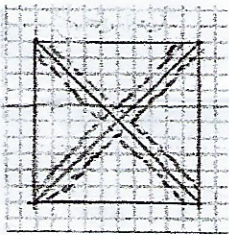

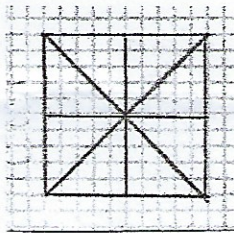
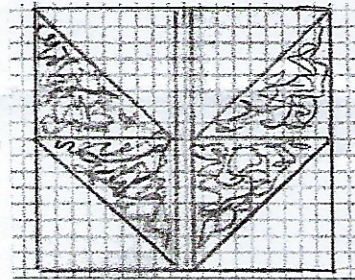

**PART 2 - the tulip:** Take the 4 white 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares and snowball the 4 – 5" bright floral squares. Make a mark from corner to corner on the 2 ½" x 2 ½" white squares. Putting one in the corner of each 5" square and sewing on the line as shown in diagram 4 below. Be sure to cut the excess off. Put together like a 4 patch (diagram 5). Put part 2 on top of part 1 to make a TULIP.

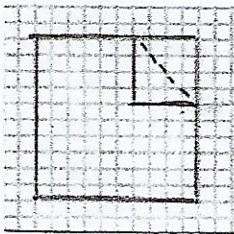
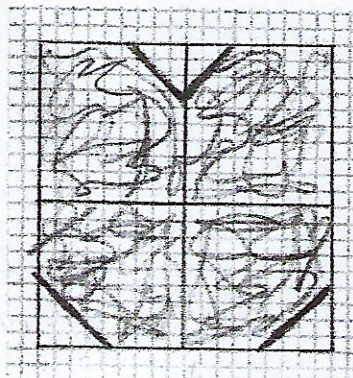
