Techniques Taught: Everbloom quilt, Freezer paper, Needle-turn Applique

Pattern:

- Everbloom pattern if making the quilt
- Pattern for State blocks in class, \$5 (optional)
- Tool kits are available for purchase \$15

Fabric Required:

- Everbloom pattern fabrics (if doing the quilt)
- A variety of Batiks are the best fabrics to use
- Background and backing: ½ yard for Sky
- A variety of batik scraps in green, browns, white, pinks, blacks and burnt orange (see pattern for more color selection.
- Boarder: ¼ yard
- Binding: ¼ yard
- 25” square of wool batting

Suggested Supplies / Tools:

- Pencil
- Frixion disappearing ink pen
- Irons-Clover Small Wedge Iron
- Cheri’s Cool Tool
- 1 glass jar 5-6 inches tall
- Oven mitten
- Small wool ironing mat (9” square is a perfect size)
- Applique Stiletto
- Applique pressing or parchment paper
- 4-inch curved scissors
- ¼ inch thick foam core board (24X36) cut in half. (bring both pieces of foam board)
- Freezer paper roll
- ¾ inch applique pins-comfort grip
- Fray Check or Fray Block
- Basting Glue
- Spray starch (trigger pump only)



Pre-Class Preparation:

Cut foam core board in half

Cut background fabric 20" square
