Class Name: Binding Four Ways

Techniques Taught:

There's more than 1 way to bind a quilt! In this class you will learn 4 unique ways: traditional handsewn, traditional machine, a facing binding and lastly a super fun serger binding. Time permitting, we'll "speed date" demo a few other techniques including a faux piping with two color binding. Book required.

Class Skill Level: Beginner

Class Supplies:

Please bring four (4) quilt sandwiches that are 8" square(-ish). These don't need to be fancy – they can be scraps, pieces you cut off from a quilt you quilted, muslin, etc. We're just practicing!

You will also need 4 strips of fabric, 2.25" x WOF.

In addition, please bring:

- Wonder clips
- Acrylic Ruler – 3 x 6; something small-ish
- Normal sewing supplies including sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal, manual for sewing machine, 50 wt thread to match your fabric or a neutral color, pins, small scissors to trim

threads, 45 mm rotary cutter with a sharp blade.

- ¼" foot, and a walking foot if you have them
- Marking tool such as a mechanical pencil or chalk marker
- *If you have a small cutting mat, please bring it!*
