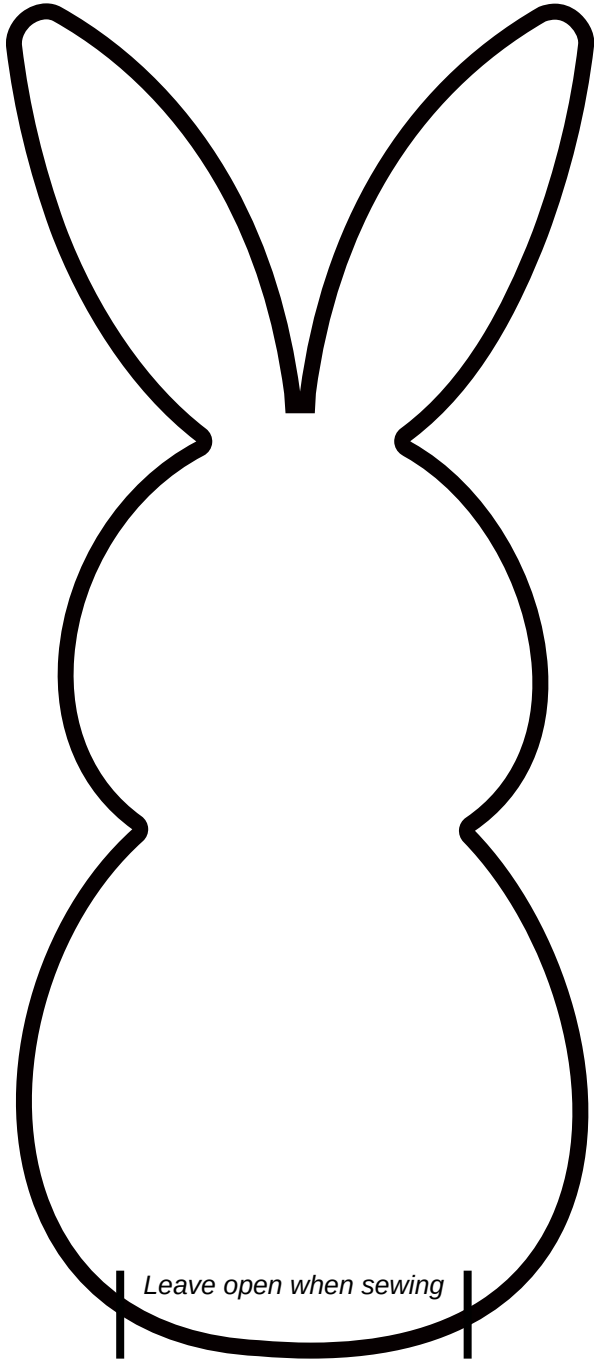


# Spring Bunny Satchet



Leave open when sewing

## Instructions:

- Gather your supplies:
  - Two coordinating pieces of 5" x 7" fabric
  - Polyfill
  - 1 Teaspoon lavender
  - Coordinating thread
  - Disappearing ink pen
  - Pinking shears
  - Sewing machine in good working order
  - Embellishments as desired - may include eyes, buttons, a bow, flowers, etc.
  - Standard sewing supplies
- Cut out the bunny to use it as a template
- Trace the bunny on to one of your fabrics using a disappearing ink pen
- Layer your fabrics, wrong sides together and stitch along the bunny outline, leaving the space at the bottom between the marks unsewn. Backstitch at your starting and ending stitches
  - Feel free to experiment with thread color or decorative stitches
- Use pinking shears to cut 1/4" around the stitching to form the bunny shape
- Use fiber fill to stuff your bunny. Add lavender as desired. Alternately, stuffing your bunny with crushed walnut shells and use it as a pincushion
- Stitch along the bottom of your bunny to close the hole

## Try other shapes:
