

Lucky Clover Wall Hanging

Fabric Requirements:

Background: Six 1/8 yard cuts off-white or enough scraps to cut 48 3 1/2 inch squares
5/8 yard off-white for setting triangles

Clover Leaves: Four 1/4 yard cuts of green

Border/Binding: 1/2 yard Kelly green

Backing: 1 1/4 yard fabric of choice

Batting: 1 1/4 yard batting of choice

Other Supplies Suggested:

Basic sewing supplies including sewing machine, thread, rotary cutter, mat, ruler, pins, seam ripper and iron.

Finished quilt is 38" x 38"

Sewing

Make 8 HSTs as follows:

- 2 of the green fabrics from units A and B
- 2 of the green fabrics from units A and C
- 2 of the green fabrics from units B and D
- 2 of the green fabrics from units C and D

Lay out the clover portion of the quilt into 8 rows of 8 squares each per the picture. 16 of your squares will be the HST you sewed. Sew each row, ironing each row to alternate sides so you can nestle your seams. Sew first six rows together and set aside. Sew last two rows together and then make your stem.

To make your stem, fold the long edges of your 1"x7" rectangle to the center and press. Then, fold it in half so the raw edges are in the center and press. Sew along the open edge with a 1/8" seam. Pin stem to last four squares of the bottom section, forming a slight curve to your liking. Sew last piece of two rows to the bottom of the first six you already sewed, embedding the stem raw edges into the top seam.

Attach inner border to top and bottom of quilt, embedding the remaining raw edge of the stem into the seam. Press open. Repeat with left and right side.

Attach a setting triangle to opposite sides of your quilt, pinning raw edges in place and sewing with a 1/4 inch seam. Press open. Repeat with remaining two setting triangles on opposite sides.

Square quilt to 38". Quilt and bind as desired.

Cutting Instructions

Assumes 42" wide fabric

1. Background: Cut (48) 3½ inch squares from background fabrics
2. Petals: Cut (14) 3½ squares from each ¼ yard piece of green clover
3. Setting Triangles: Cut (2) 20 inch squares from 5/8 yard off white. Then, cut again diagonally so you have 4 triangles
4. Inner Border: Cut (4) 1½ inch strips from Kelly green
5. Stem: Cut (1) 1½" x 7" rectangle from Kelly Green
6. Binding: Cut (4) 2½ inch strips from Kelly

Tip...

Arrange fabrics according to picture, labeling the clovers as units A, B, C, D

Background for clover is scrappy.



Sewing

Use a 1/4 inch seam for all sewing unless otherwise indicated

Make 2 off-white and green half square triangles (HST) for each clover for a total of 8. To make the HST:

- Draw a pencil line diagonally on 8 off-white 3½ inch squares

- **Discard** right sides (white and green) together, **Cut here** on pencil line
- **Sew here** 1/4 inch from seam and discard
- Iron HST open
