

Charted Heart Quilt Design

Supply List

Size: 52 x 55 inches

Supply List

Fabric:

A variety of fabrics ranging from 1/2 yard to 1½ yards in length. Many fat quarters could work as well in to plan.

A good variety of color, scale and design. Largest yardage used for nine patches and blocks surrounding heart.

Flannel, batting or something of your choice measuring at least 60 x 65 inches for quilt layout, design & transport.

Really Important!!

These fabric requirements are for the quilt top only!!!

Backing and binding can be purchased or determined upon completion of the quilt top.

Homework:

Iron all creases from any fabric you choose to bring to class. Specifically iron out the folded crease from the center of the fabric as it is folded on the bolt. Gently refold or place you fabric on a hanger to transport and avoid creasing. Makes for the very best workmanship!

Tools:

Sewing machine in good working order and a capable operator.

80/12 sewing machines needles in the event one should break.

Neutral color thread and bobbins filled and ready to stitch.

Rotary Cutter, Mat, Straight ruler, Square ruler.

Straight Ruler should be at least 3 x 14 inches with 1/4 inch marks clear on ruler.

Square ruler should be at least 8 inches square. (not required)

Wonder Clips (12) or pins for project transport at end of class.

Any other tool or item that you prefer to use when piecing quilt blocks i.e. small scissor or trimmers, awl, pins, seam ripper etc.

Blue painters tape 1 inch wide to tape design surface to wall temporarily. (optional or provided/shared by shop/ guild)

Cell phones on vibrate please. Be considerate of the instructor and students.
