**Class Name:** Holiday Folded Star Table Topper



**Instructor:** Stacey Murren

**Techniques Taught:**

- Piecing, quick and easy prairie points

**Pattern / Book Required:**

- Folded Star Table Topper Interfacing Template

**Fabric Required:**

- 3/8-yard of four different fabrics, for making prairie points
- 8, (5 ½ X 5) repeat motifs for the center of kaleidoscope, amount of yardage needed depends on the number of repeats within the designs of the fabric
- 5/8-yard for backing or (20X21 piece)
- 5/8-yard fusible fleece, light weight
- ¼-yard for binding

**Suggested Supplies / Tools:**

- The perfect 5 ruler (recommended) or 23-inch quilters ruler
- Point of View Kaleidoscope ruler (Plum Easy)
- Open toe sewing foot (Bernina #20)
- Roxanne's Glue-Baste- It, 2-way applicator
- Spray Starch
- Large plastic bag, for using under template when gluing pieces in place
- Metal Prairie Pointer Pressing Tool (size, finishing from 1/2" up to 2½")
- Stiletto
- Rotary cutter

**Threads:**

- 1 spool of monopoly thread, clear for light fabric, smoke for dark fabrics
- Matching threads for the four prairie point fabrics
